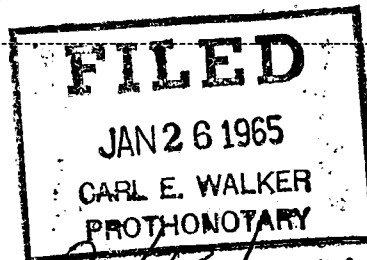

Dear Mr. Walker:


Mr. Gaylor has written us explaining that you are holding \$27.35 paid by him in escrow.
