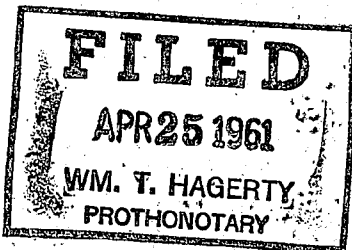

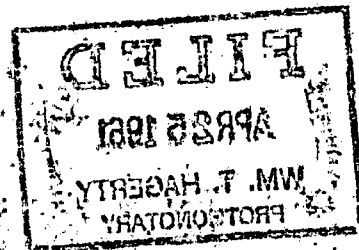

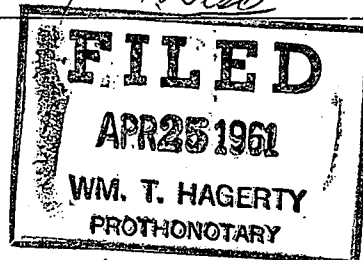

COMPLAINT

And now comes JOHN ALAN PIFER, WILLIAM J. PIFER and WILLIAM L. PIFER, trading as G. W. PIFER SONS, and by their attorneys, Gleason, Cherry & Cherry, files this Complaint in Assumpsit against HARRY COOK, upon a cause of action whereof the following is a statement:

1. The Plaintiffs, JOHN ALAN PIFER, WILLIAM J. PIFER, and WILLIAM L. PIFER, partners, trading as G. W. PIFER SONS, are dealers in lumber, millwork and builders supplies, and are residents of DuBois, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania.

2. The Defendant, HARRY COOK, is an individual who resides at 206 Tozier Avenue, DuBois, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania.

3. The Plaintiffs, at DuBois, Pennsylvania, at the special instance and request of the Defendant, sold and delivered to the Defendant lumber and building supplies, at the time, in the amounts, of the kinds, and for the prices set forth in a true and correct copy of account taken from the Plaintiffs' book of original entry hereto attached and marked Exhibit "A".

4. The prices charged for said lumber and building

supplies are just and reasonable, and are the prices which the Defendant promised to pay Plaintiffs for the same.

5. The Plaintiffs have demanded payment from the Defendant for the amount due, but the Defendant has refused and still refuses to pay the same, or any part thereof.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiffs demand judgment against the Defendant for the sum of Three Hundred Dollars and Seventeen Cents (\$300.17), with interest from the 30th day of December, 1958.
