The petition of the undersigned inha-

sheweth, that a road has been long since laid out from
the "Lily Fording" on Big Bleasfield Creek to the George Lake
place now owned and occupied by Wilson Hoover, when the
new bridge across said Creek has been erected. That
said road runs over a hill, making the distance great, and
the road very expensive to keep up. Your petitioners con-
sider, that it has become inconvenient and burdensome to
inhabitants of said Township, that a road can be laid out
and made from said Fording aforementioned, to Williston
along said Creek, which will be very much shorter, and
much more convenient for the traveling public. Your
petitioners therefore pray, that viewers may be appointed
to view said road, and vacate and supply the same
agreeably to the act of the General Assembly in such
case made and provided, and they will pray &c.

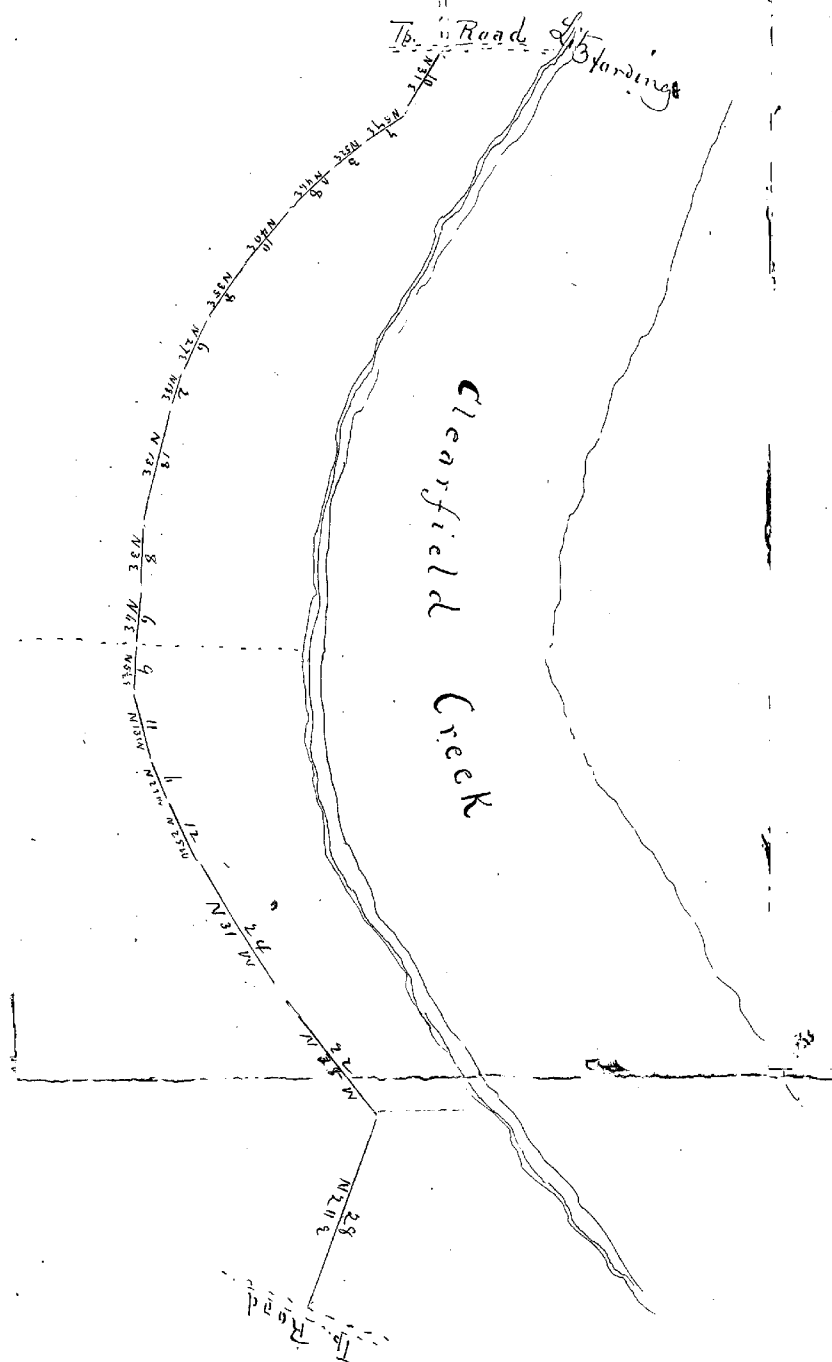

Horner thence N 57° W. 9 perches, thence N 13° W. 11 perches, thence N 22° W. 6 perches, thence N 25° W. 12 perches, thence N 31° W. 24 perches, thence N 38° W. 22 perches, thence N 20° E. 28 perches to Sp.
