To the Honorable the Judges of the Court
of Quarter Sessions of the Peace for the
County of Clearfield;
At March Sessions 1877

The petition of the undersigned Citizens
of Burnside Township in said County, re-
spectfully presents. That that portion of
the public road known as the old State
road, leading from Diamond Mills, Du-
rham County, to Curwensville, which passes
through the farms owned or in possession
of Dr A. White in Burnside Township,
has become dangerous, by reason of the
river having washed away a portion
of the ground upon which said road
was located, and the refusal of said Dr A.
White to allow his fences to be moved back
in order to appropriate more ground
for the road.

Your Petitioners therefore pray that
viewers be appointed to view said road,
and to make a report to vacate and sup-
ply such parts thereof as may be necessary
and proper, between a point on said
road 100 rods above the land of said
White, and another point on said road 100
rods below said Whites land,

And so they will pray.
