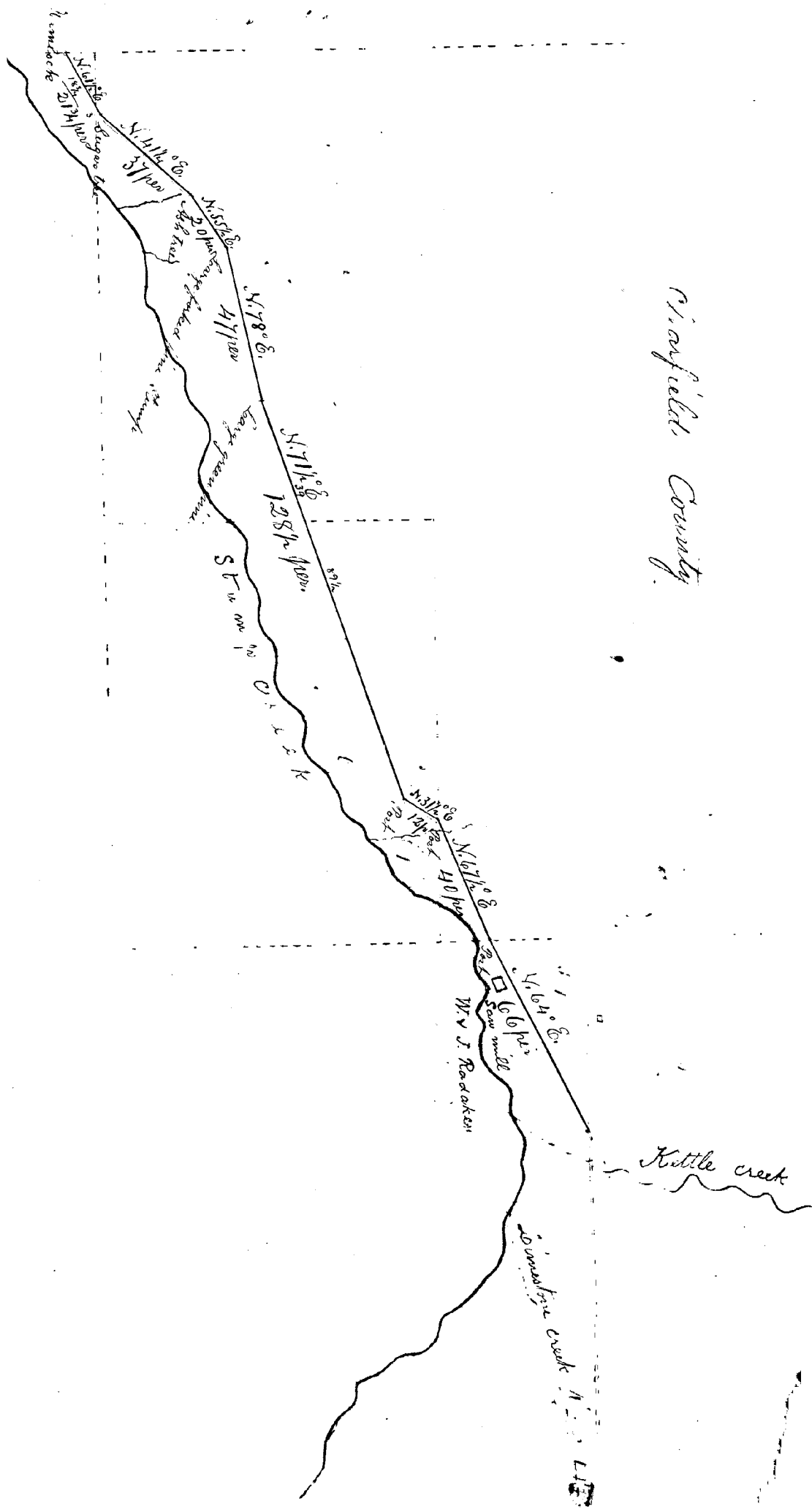

# Road Viewers' Report.

CLEARFIELD COUNTY, SS:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of March, A. D. 1872, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of Brady, in said county, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a road or highway, leading from the public Road at or near Geo. Kriners thence by the nearest and best route until it intersects the public road leading from Henry Shapers to the Jefferson Co. Line

"Report as to Damages &c,"

And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same, according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint David Ream, J. A. Rishel and Henry Kriner who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said road; and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, with reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.

To the Honorable the Judges of the  
Court of Quarter Sessions of Clearfield Co.  
We the undersigned viewers appointed by the above  
order of Court to view and lay out the road  
therein mentioned respectfully report.

That having given due and public notice  
of the time and place of said view by printed  
handbills as required by the act of Assembly, we  
met at the time and place appointed, and after  
being duly sworn or affirmed according to law,  
and all the viewers being present we went upon  
the ground proposed for said view, and having  
viewed the same we report for Public use the  
following road to wit:— Beginning at a hemlock  
on Jefferson and Clearfield county line on Tract No.  
462 and  $9\frac{1}{2}$  per. South from the N.W. corner of said  
Tract; Thence through woodlands of A. H. McClure No. 462  
N.  $61\frac{1}{2}$  deg. E.  $18\frac{3}{4}$  per. to Tract line and 3 per. more being  $21\frac{3}{4}$  per.  
to a sugar tree; Thence through woodlands of McClure  
Cathers & Co. Tract No. 492. N.  $41\frac{1}{4}$  deg. E. 37 per. to a  
large Ash tree; thence through said lands N.  $55\frac{1}{2}$  deg.  
E. 20 per. to a large forked pine stump; thence through  
said lands N.  $78$  deg. E.  $47$  per. to a large green pine tree;  
thence through said lands N.  $71\frac{1}{2}$  deg. E. 39 per. to line of  
lands of George Ogden, then by same bearing through lands  
of said Geo. Ogden  $89\frac{1}{2}$  per. more being  $128\frac{1}{2}$  per. to post  
in improved lands of G. Ogden; thence through said  
improved lands of Geo. Ogden N.  $31\frac{1}{2}$  deg. E. 12 per. to post  
on line of Geo. Ogden; Thence through woodlands of McClure  
Cathers & Co. N.  $67\frac{1}{2}$  deg. E. 40 per. to post on line of Wm.  
& James Radaker; thence through improved lands of  
W. & J. Radaker N.  $64$  deg. E. 66 per. to intersect public  
road leading past Jm. T. Kishel's Sawmill a draft  
or plot whereof is hereunto annexed which said  
road we report as necessary and we further  
report no damages to accrue from said road.
