ROAD VIEWER'S REPORT.

CLEARFIELD COUNTY SS:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the 11th day of January, A. D. 1872, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of Goshen, in the said county, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a road or highway, leading from

Daniel Cyphers to the
Public Road at or near Ephraim F. Shaws
"Report as to Damages &c"

And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same, according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

John L. Luttle, A. A. Read & Geo. A. Morrison
who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said road; and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, with reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.

We, the persons appointed by the within order of Court to view and lay out the road therein named, do Report, that after giving due legal notice of the time and place of meeting of the viewers, ~~by~~ advertised to put up in public places in the township of Gosport, and being first duly sworn went upon the ground and have laid out and now return for Public use the following courses and distances, beginning at a corner of Daniel Stephens field thence South 18° West, Five Perches, North $87^{\circ} 16'$ 24 perches, South 11° West 24 perches, South 27° West (at 12 Spruce Run) 16 perches, South 16° East 14 perches, South 5° East 28 perches, South 39° West 20 perches, South 52° West 14 perches, South 66° West 27 perches, South 49° West 30 perches, South 60° West 20 perches, South $48^{\circ} 16'$ 12 perches, South 75° West 18 perches North 87° West Ninety four Perches to township road near Pitch Pine corner of Shaw & Leonard, and we judge the same necessary for Public use. All which is respectfully submitted.
