Road Viewers' Report.

CLEARFIELD COUNTY, SS:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the *fourteenth* day of *June*, A. D. 1872, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of *Lehest*, in said county, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a road or highway, leading from *at or near Robert Pennington's Jr.* to intersect the public Road leading to *Breth's Mills* "Report as to Damages &c"

And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same, according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

Thos. H. Moore, S. Montgomery and G. Tozer

who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said road; and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make

report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, with reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.

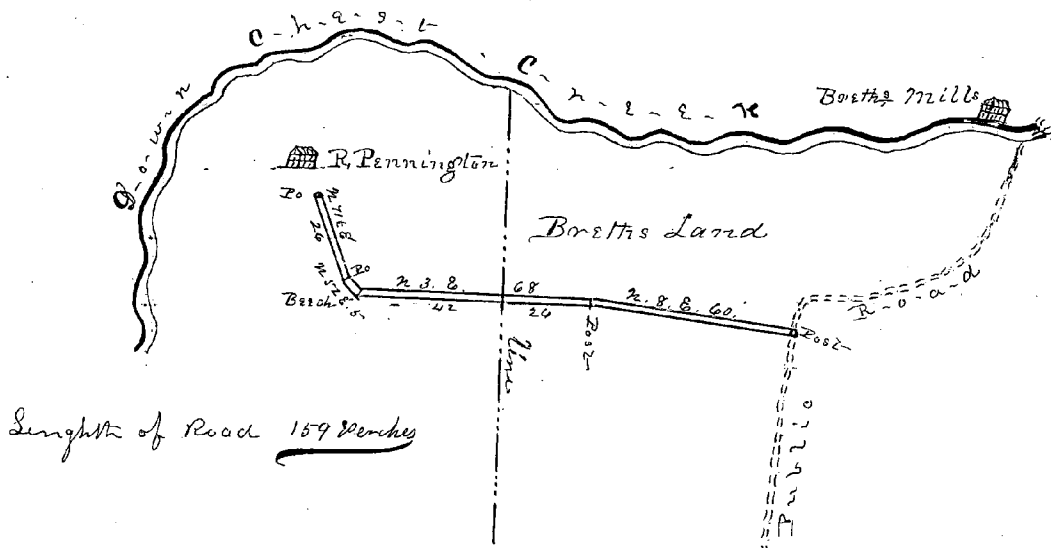

That in pursuance of said Order after having given due notice according to law of the time & place of said view and we having enquired as to the Damage resulting to any one by reason of the passage of said road have ascertained that no Damage results to any one and after being duly affirmed we did proceed to view lay out and determine for Public use the following road (Viz.) Beginning at a Post by Robert Pennington fence thence through Pennington's land North Seventy one & one half degrees East Twenty six Perches to a Post. North Fifty-two degrees East. Five perches to a Beech. Thence North 3° by East Sixty Eight Perches to a Post on land of Boeth's Bros. Thence North Eight degrees East Sixty Perches to a Post on the Public road leading to Boeth's Mills. a Plot or Draft of which we hereunto annex
