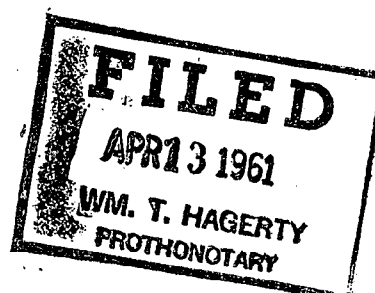

FIRST: The Proctor Electric Company is a corporation with offices and place of business at No. 700 West Tabor Road, Philadelphia 20, Pa.


SECOND: The defendant is a corporation with offices at No. 203 DuBois Street, in the City of DuBois, Clearfield County, Pa.

THIRD: That the defendant purchased from the plaintiff on June 26, 1959 and actually received and retained 72 electric toasters, Model No. 1490A, at a value of \$6.25 each, or a total of \$450.00; 96 electric irons, Model No. 1803, at a value of \$6.25 each, or a total of \$600.00; and 2 electric toasters, Model No. 20301, at a value of \$6.97 each, or a total of \$13.94, a total value of \$1063.94.

FOURTH: That the defendant has paid on account of such purchase payments aggregating \$400.00 reducing the balance owing to \$663.94, with interest thereon from July 26, 1959 at 6% per annum.


WHEREFORE, plaintiff seeks to recover of the defendant \$663.94 with interest from July 26, 1959 and costs

of suit.


