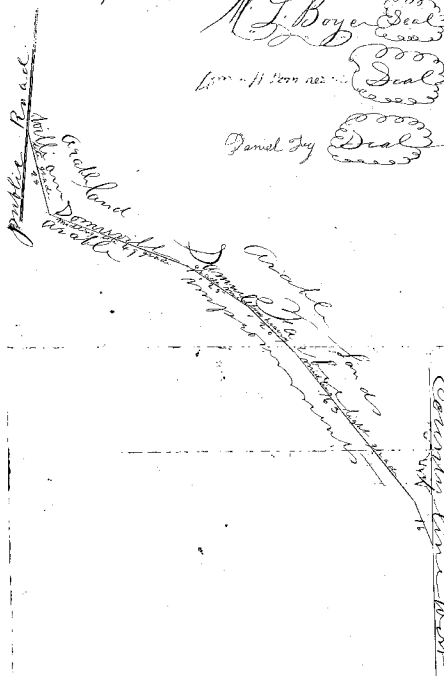

do report: that in pursuance
thereof after giving due and
public notice according to law
having been duly sworn and
affirmed all the jurors by said
order having viewed the ground
proposed for the within mentioned
road and the undesignated views
do agree there is occasion for a
road as desired by the petitioners
and that the same is necessary
for a public road and having
had respect to the shortest distance
and best ground for such road
we have laid it out in such a
manner as to do the least injury to
private property and as far as
practicable agreeable to the desires of
the petitioners and to return for public
use the following described road
commencing at the public road near
Somerville field thence South
twenty six and a half degrees
west twenty eight perches thence
South nineteen and a half degrees
west forty nine perches being through
the arable lands of William Somerville
thence through the arable lands of
Samuel Farber the following
course and distances South thirty
two and a half degrees west twenty
five perches thence South forty
three and a half degrees west
twenty perches thence South fifty
degrees west thirty three perches
thence South fifty six and a half
degrees west fifteen perches to the
County line continuing the two
hundred and one perches of same
assessed from a plot or draft where
of is hereunto annexed which said
road do as afore said laid out
we are of the opinion is necessary
for a public road

ROAD VIEWER'S REPORT.

CLEARFIELD COUNTY SS:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the Eleventh day of January, A. D. 1872, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of Chest, in the said county, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a road or highway, leading from the Township Road between Mrs. James Summerville's past Mr. Farbers to the Cambria County line.

Report as to damages &c

And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same, according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

Lewis Boice Mr. Summerville & Daniel Fry who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said road; and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, with reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.
