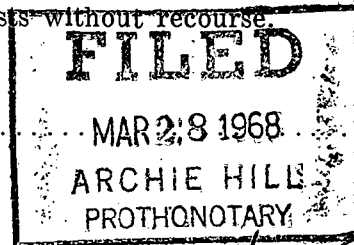

And the undersigned, in the event of such default, hereby authorizes any Attorney at Law to appear in any Court of Record in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania or elsewhere in the United States and waive the issuing and service of process and confess judgment against us, or either or any of us, in favor of the holder of this note for the amount appearing due and costs of suit, and thereupon to release all errors and waive all right of appeal and stay of execution in our behalf; hereby authorizing the holder to apply hereon at any time any moneys owing by such holder to us, or either or any of us, and further agreeing that in case of insolvency, business failure or default on this or any other obligation to the holder, then, at the option of the holder, this and all other obligations shall at once become due and payable, without demand or notice, with interest after maturity.
