ANSWER TO SCIRE FACIAS TO REVIVE

The Answer of Roy H. Lutz and Grace M. Lutz avers as follows:

1. That by agreement among the above named defendants and their creditors the liens of Seneca Coal and Iron Corporation were to be subsequent to the liens of C. J. Semple and J. Hylan Lewis and Hollis Lewis, except on a certain described property of the defendants in Lawrence Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania.

2. That the defendants and the other creditors, except the above named plaintiff, have executed amicable revivals continuing the liens as agreed and the defendants have offered to execute like amicable revivals for the present plaintiff.

3. That no revival of lien should be entered under the plaintiff's scire facias except in accordance with the original agreement among the defendants and their creditors as to priority of liens.

WHEREFORE, the defendants ask that in the above action judgment be entered in favor of the defendants with costs on the plaintiff.
