Road Viewers' Report.

CLEARFIELD COUNTY, SS:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the *Fifth* day of *June*, A. D. 1872, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of *Burnside*, in said county, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a road or highway, leading from *New Washington to the Village of Burnside* — *Beginning at the Stone Corner of John M. Riddle and vacate and supply said road to the Village of Burnside* —

Report as to Damages &c.

And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same, according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

Thos. H. Moore, David Bell, Jackson Patchin who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said road; and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, with reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.

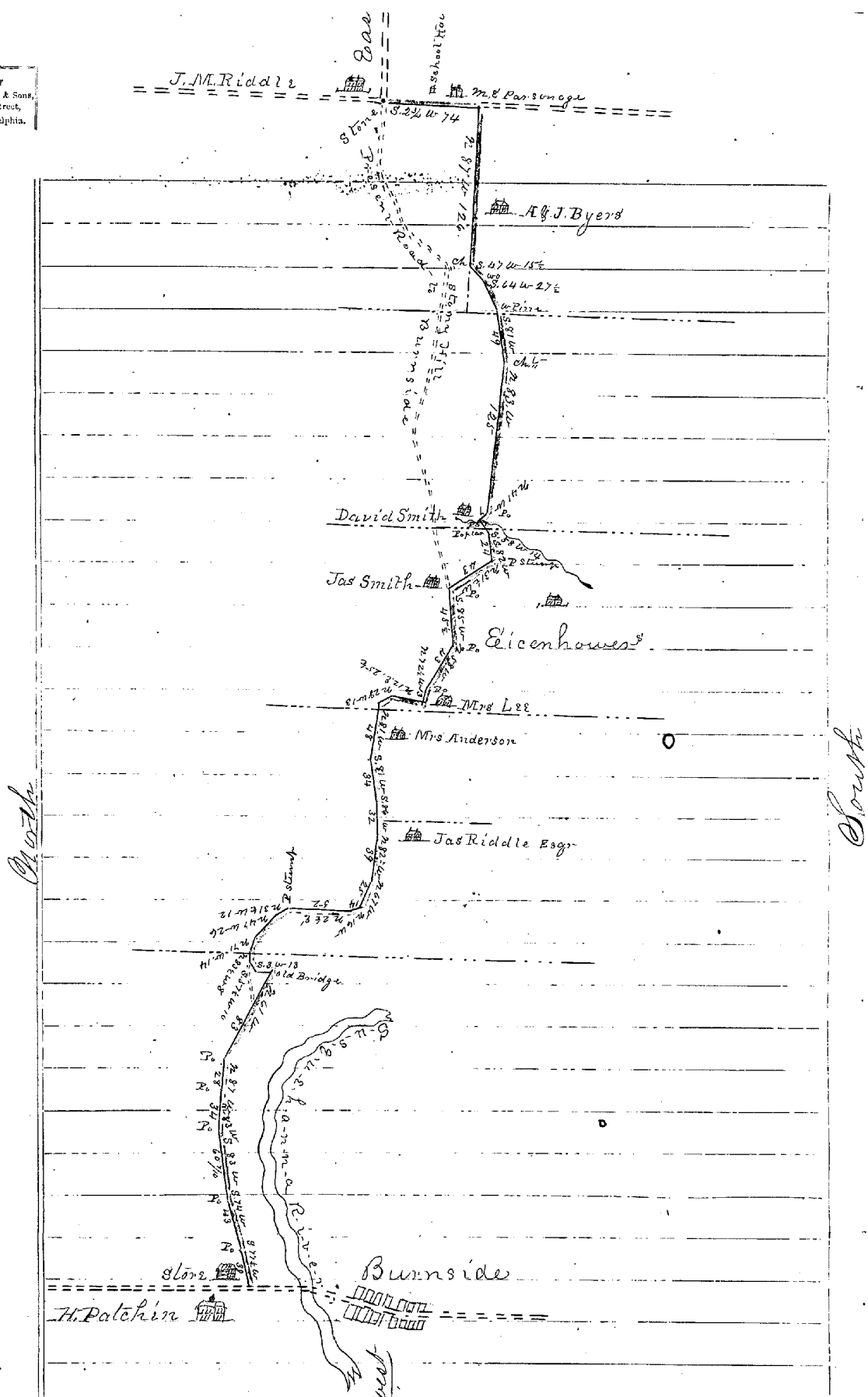

To the Honorable Judges within named.

We the undersigned Viewers appointed by the foregoing order of Court to view the road therein described. Do Report, that in pursuance of said appointment, after having first given due notice thereof by written and pointed advertisements put up according to Law of the time and place of said View, and also having given notice to the Owners and occupants of land through which said road was intended to pass of the same, and we having enquired as to the damages resulting to any one by reason of the passage of the said road, have ascertained that no damage results to any one, and having been duly Affirmed, we have changed, Vacated, and Supplied said road by the following courses and distances, Beginning at the Stone corner of John M. Riddell thence by a public road S. $2\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$ W. $7\frac{1}{4}$ Perches, thence through lands & along line between Atchison and James Byers N. 87° W. 126 perches to a Chest. S. $47\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W. $15\frac{1}{2}$ Perches to a Oak, S. 64° W. $27\frac{1}{2}$ Perches to a white Pine on line of E. & W. Smith, then through corner S. 81° W. 49 Perches to a Chest, then along Smiths fence N. 83° W. 125 Perches to a Post, N. 41° W. 7 Perches to Post, S. 58° W. 14 Perches to a Poplar on land of Eichenhower, & through land of same S. 82° W. 24 Perches to a 2^d W.
