





the plaintiff named in the above entitled judgment, for and in consideration of the sum of one Dollar, lawful money of the United States, to them paid by the defendant, above named, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby forever acquit, exonerate, discharge and release from the lien of the above entitled judgment, the following described property, to-wit:

ALL that certain piece or parcel of land situate in Woodward Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, bounded and described as follows: BEGINNING at a stake and stones corner on the Southern right-of-way line of State Highway Route No. 53 leading from Houtzdale to Madera; thence along the Southern right-of-way line, these following courses and distances; South seventy-three (73) degrees thirty-five (35) minutes East a distance of one hundred thirty-four (134) feet to a stake corner; thence South eighty-four (84) degrees five (5) minutes East a distance of one hundred seventy and sixty hundredths (170.60) feet to a stake corner; thence North eighty-seven (87) degrees three (3) minutes East a distance of one hundred seven and fifteen hundredths (107.5) feet to a stake and stones corner on the Southern right-of-way line of said highway and said stake and stones corner being on the Western right-of-way line of the Pennsylvania Railroad; thence along the Western right-of-way of the Penna.
