ROAD VIEWER'S REPORT.

CLEARFIELD COUNTY SS:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the Eleventh day of January, A. D. 1872, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of Brady, in the said county, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a road or highway, leading from near where the East and West line of Mers Abel Brooks crosses the public road leading to Fred. Shapers by the nearest and best route to a point in the aforesaid at or near Shapers Bridge

"Report as to Damages"

And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same, according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

John Potter, Joseph Posthewait and David Reams

who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said road; and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, with reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.

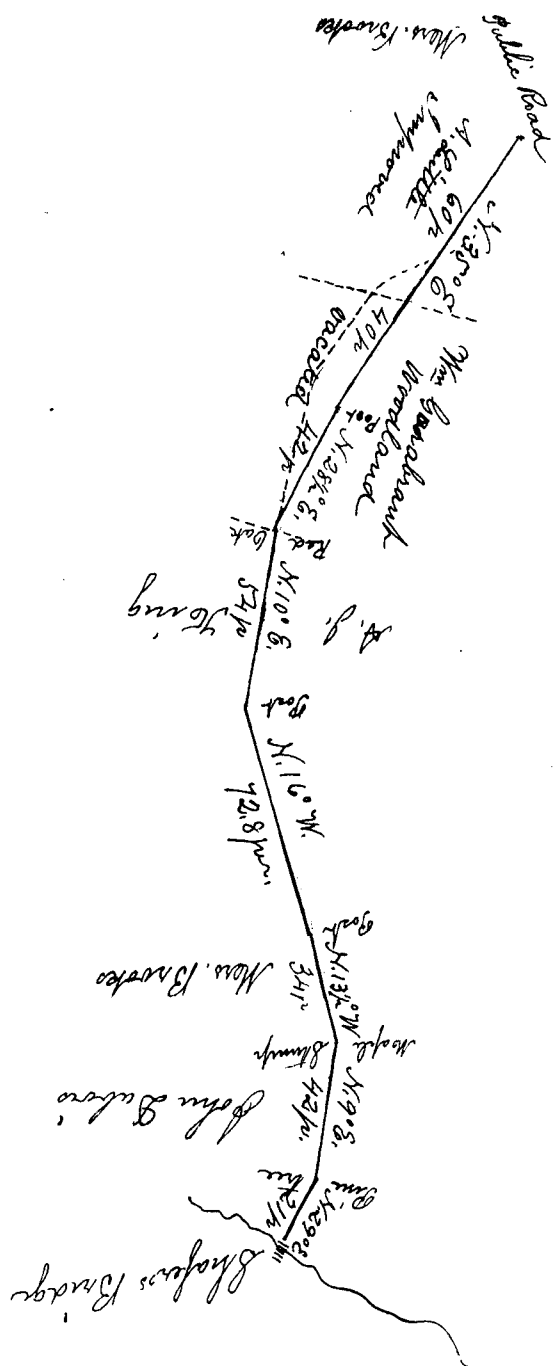

To the Honorable the Judges of the
Court of Quarter Sessions of Clearfield County

We the undersigned Reviewers appointed by
the above order of Court to Review and lay out the
road therein mentioned respectfully report. —

That having given due and public notice
of the time and place of said review by printed
handbills as required by the act of Assembly, we met
at the time and place appointed, and after being duly
sworn or affirmed according to law, and all the
reviewers being present we went upon the ground proposed
for said review, and having reviewed the same we
report for public use the following road to wit: —

Beginning in the public road "near where the east and
west line of Mers. A. Brooks crosses the public road", thence
by Improved lands of Andrew Little N. 35° East 60 per.
to line of A. Little and Wm Garubrant, then by same bearing
through wood lands of said Garubrant 40 per. to post at the
head of the ravine; thence by said wood lands N. $28\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E.
42 per. to Red Oak on north line of said Garubrant and
intersection to the old road; thence by lands of A. J. King
N. 10° E. 54 per. to post; thence by said lands N. 16° West 72.8
per. to post on line of lands of A. J. King; thence by other lands
of Mers. Brooks N. $13\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W. 34 per. to maple stump; thence by
said lands N. 9° E. 42 per. to a pine tree; thence through
lands of John Dubois N. 29° E. 21 per. to Shafer's Bridge

A plot or draft whereof is herewith annexed which
said road we report as necessary and to have the other
or old parts of said road vacated which by means of the open-
ing of the new road becomes useless, and we further report
no damages to accrue from said road

The petitioners of the undersigned citizens of Cradock Township respectfully protest against the Confirmation absolutely of a "certain road leading at or near where the East & West line on the North side of Mrs. Able Brooks crosses the public road leading to Fred Shaffers by the nearest and best route to a point in the upper-
"such road at or near Shaffers Bridge"
The petitioners respectfully represent that the proposed road is not laid out on the nearest and best route, and to open it as proposed would entail a heavy expense upon the town without any corresponding advantage, that the old road proposed to be vacated is located on better ground, is more direct and a shorter distance than the road laid out as asked to be opened. They therefore ask that a review may be granted, to change the location of the road as now reported.
