Represents,

That the Township of
Brady by reason of its size &c. is
inconvenient to the inhabitants thereof
and that the convenience and advantage
of said inhabitants would be greatly
promoted by dividing said Township
by a line. Beginning on Jefferson
County line at North West Cor. of
Tract No. 462 thence East along said
Tract to North East Cor. of said Tract
thence South to North West Cor. of Henry
Gillispie Land thence East to North East
Cor. of Henry Kuars Land thence South
along Land of Henry Kuars Jacob
Schuerm David Adams and G. B.
Woodward to Bell Township Line
thence East along said line to Cor.
of said Township thence South along
line of Bell and Penn Townships
to South East Cor. of Tract No. 4989
thence West along Tract line
to Jefferson County line, thence

North along said line to

To the Honorable the Judges of the
Court of Quarter Sessions of Clearfield Co.

We the undersigned commissioners
appointed by the annexed order of Court
to inquire into the propriety of granting the
prayer of the petitioners and erecting a new
township out of parts of Brady and parts of
Bell townships and establish the lines and
boundaries thereof respectfully report the following:

That having given due and public notice
of the time and place of meeting for said
purpose, by handbills put up in different
conspicuous places as required by the act of
Assembly, we met upon the ground proposed
for meeting for the same, and all the com-
missioners being present viz. John Smith, John
Dressler, and David Kearns, and after being duly
sworn or affirmed according to law, we pro-
ceeded to inquire into the expediency of granting
the prayer of the petitioners and are of opinion
that the lines named in the petition are not
as they should be on account of dividing the
school sub districts; but are also of opinion that
a new township out of parts of Brady and parts
of Bell townships should be erected with bound-
aries somewhat different from those named in
the petition and more completely separate the
school sub districts and therefore we have proceeded
to lay out a New Township with the following
lines and boundaries, viz.

Beginning at the Jefferson county line on
the North west corner of Tract No. 462 in Brady
township; thence East by said tract line 548 perches

more or less to the North west corner of James
Woodside tract; Thence South between lands of
Geo. J. Weaver on the east and John Lais and Geo.
Weisgarber on the west 122 per. more or less to
line of lands of Godfrey Gilcox decd (now G. J. Yoas);
Thence East between lands of Geo. J. Weaver on the
North and G. J. Yoas and Carlile & Moore on the South
180 per. more or less to line of lands of T. F. Rishel;
Thence South between lands of T. F. Rishel on the
east and Carlile & Moore on the west 48 per. more
or less to South west corner of T. F. Rishel; Thence
East between lands of T. F. Rishel, Geo. J. Weaver, Henry
Saxman, George Kintz, Daniel Goodlander and James
Miles on the north; and Carlile and Moore,
Weaver & Edinger (Grist mill lot), Adam Wood, Henry
Weaver, Henry Muarr, Nicholas Fess, Lewis Feigler and
Frederic Feigler, (or Geo. Aurand) on the South 546
perches more or less to line of lands of E. G. Hoays;
Thence South between lands of E. G. Hoays on the east
and Geo. Aurand on the west 74 per. more or less to
South west corner of lands of E. G. Hoays; Thence East
between lands of E. G. Hoays on the north, and George
Aurand on the South 30 per. more or less to corner
of lands of Geo. H. Wingert; Thence South between

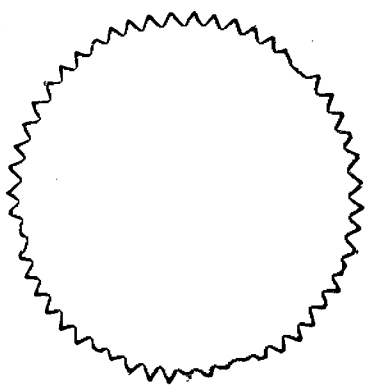

inhabitants of the Townships of Brady in said County was duly presented, praying that a new Township be erected out a part of Brady Township with the following lines and boundaries viz-

"Beginning on the line of Brady and Jefferson County line at the North West Corner of tract No. 462, thence East along said tract to the North East Corner of said tract - thence South to North West corner of Henry Zilliox's land, thence East to North East corner of Henry Knarr's - thence South along lands of Henry Knarr, Jacob Schwem, David Ream, and G. B. Goodlander to Bell Township line - thence East along said line to corner of said Township, thence South along line of Bell and Penn Township to the South East corner of tract No. 4289, thence West along tract lines to Jefferson County line thence North along said Jefferson County line to the place of Beginning."

And said Petitioners further prayed the Court to appoint Commissioners to view said lines and to take such steps as are proper and necessary to erect such new Township, according to the provisions of the Act of Assembly in such case as made and provided -

And thereupon 20 March 1872, the said Court being fully informed of the matter, upon due consideration had of the premises, do appoint

Sam. F. McCloskey, James Thompson and Saml. Jenkins the aforesaid Commissioners, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity And having also given notice to the Supervisors or some of them of said Brady Township and also to the Citizens of said Township by hand bills put up in at least five of the most public places in said Township at least eight days before the time and place of meeting to proceed to view the boundaries and inquire into the propriety of granting the prayer of the petitioners. And you or any two of you are to make a plot or draft of the Township proposed to be divided and of the division line proposed to be made therein, And of the Township proposed to be laid off, if the same cannot be fully designated by natural lines or boundaries. All of which you, or any two of you shall report to the next Court of Quarter Sessions of said County, together with your opinion of the same,
