COMPLAINT IN ASSUMPSIT

Plaintiff brings this action against defendant and for cause of complaint alleges:

1. That the plaintiff is Southern Carpet Mills, Inc., a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of New York, with its principal place of business at 754 Jamaica Avenue, Brooklyn, New York.

2. That the defendant is LaMar R. Boucher, an individual trading and doing business as DuBois Floor Company.

3. The plaintiff at the special instance and request of the defendant, sold and delivered to defendant certain goods, wares and merchandise of the kinds and descriptions as set forth on the invoices which are attached hereto, made a part hereof, and marked Exhibits A, B and C inclusive, said invoices being true and correct copies from plaintiff's books of original entry.

4. That the prices charged defendant for said goods, wares and merchandise sold to defendant as aforesaid, are fair and reasonable and the prices which defendant agreed to pay to plaintiff for the same.


5. That the total amount of said goods, wares and merchandise is Three hundred eighty-one and 65/100 (\$381.65) Dollars, and that on November 22, 1960, defendant paid the sum of Twenty (\$20.00) Dollars to apply on said amount, leaving a balance due

and owing to plaintiff of Three hundred sixty-one and 65/100 (\$361.65) Dollars.

6. That although plaintiff has made frequent demands upon defendant for payment of the balance so due, nevertheless the defendant has failed, refused and neglected to pay said balance or any part thereof to the plaintiff or to any other person for the plaintiff.

7. That this claim is not based upon a writing.

WHEREFORE, plaintiff demands judgment against defendant in the amount of Three hundred sixty-one and 65/100 (\$361.65) Dollars, with legal interest thereon from January 18, 1961.





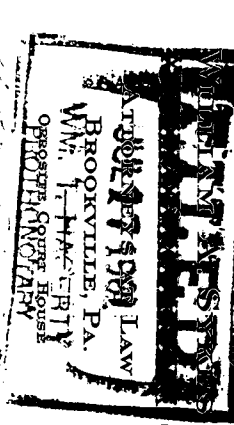

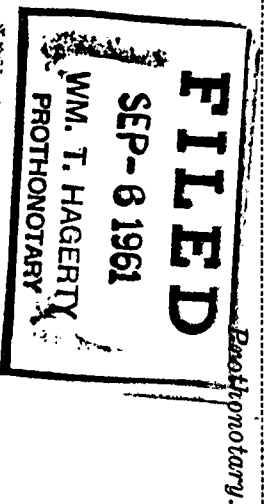
