# Road Viewers' Report.

CLEARFIELD COUNTY, SS:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of March, A. D. 1872, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of ~~Howard~~, in said county, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience of ~~a change of~~ for the want of a road or highway, leading from

Bulah at the place where the said Road intersects the plank Road at the corner of Isaac Heagerty's lot —

## "Report as to Damages &c."

And, therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same, according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

Sam'l. Heagerty, Sam'l. Shoff and Fredk. Shoff,

who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said road; and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, with reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.



We the subscribers the persons herein appointed by said Court to view and lay out the road therein mentioned, report that having been first sworn or affirmed in the manner and form prescribed by the said order that we have viewed the ground for the proposed change of road also change and lay out and now return the same for a public road, beginning at a point in the Bulah road one half mile from where it intersects the plank Road thence north eighty-one degrees west seven tenths of a mile to a point in the plank Road with reference to the improvements through which it passes a plot or draft whereof is hereto annexed.
