Road Viewers' Report.

CLEARFIELD COUNTY, SS:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the 12th day of June, A. D. 1872, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of Clearfield, in said county, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a ~~road~~ or highway, leading from 3rd Street to the alley in rear of Lot no. 1, in Mopps Addition and now owned by Robert Mitchell and said alley to be viewed and located being in the rear of Lots no^s. 2, 3, 4 and 5 in said Mopps Addition "Report as to damages &c"

And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same, according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

H. D. Bigler, Jr. W. Wright & Joseph Shaw who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said ~~road~~ alley, and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such ~~road~~ alley, they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a ~~road~~ alley, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, with reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.


The undersigned severally &
jointly by the annexed order of Court
respectfully report: That having given
due & public notice of said view according
to the act of assembly, and having been
severally sworn, we went on the ground
at the time mentioned in said notice,
and having examined the same, with a
view to the best ground and the least in-
jury to private property, we have located
an alley for public use as follows:

as in the rear of Lots No 2, 3, 4 & 5 in
Merrick's addition, the said alley to begin
at a point on extended Third St, 172 feet
from Walnut Street Thence due West in the
rear of said lots, to an alley in the rear
of Lot No 1 in Merrick's addition, the said
alley so located to be 16 feet in width, a
plot whereof is hereto annexed, & conveniently a
necessity. Your Ours also report, damage to
the owner or owners of the lot of ground on
the South side of said located alley to the amount
of Sixty dollars ($\$60$) to be paid by the lot owners
on the North side of said alley; the said lot
owners on the North side of said alley also to be
at the expence of lifting & resetting the South
boundary fence of said alley when the same is
opened.
