

SUBORDINATION OF LIEN

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that, for a good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the undersigned, the holders of a judgment entered as a lien to the above number and term do hereby subordinate their judgment lien to the lien of the mortgage and bond of the Clearfield Trust Company against Roy H. Lutz and Grace M. Lutz dated February 2, 1962 and recorded in Mortgage Book 197 Page 411 in the amount of \$12,000.00 and do hereby release any claim to payment of their said lien from the following described property prior to the payment of the lien of the mortgage and bond of the Clearfield Trust Company as aforementioned, all of that property located in Lawrence Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, bounded and described as follows:

THE FIRST THEREOF: Known as Lot No. 58 in the plot of lots laid out by A. F. Boynton bounded on the West by Poplar Avenue, on the North by Lot No. 57, on the East by a public alley and on the South by Lot No. 59, being fifty (50) feet south on Poplar Avenue and of uniform width and extending back from Poplar Avenue one hundred fifty (150) feet to the line of the public alley in the rear.

BEING the same premises which Mildred E. Watson by her deed dated October 3, 1939, recorded in the Recorder's Office for Clearfield County in Deed Book 328 at page 460, granted and conveyed to Roy H. Lutz and Grace Lutz.



THE SECOND THEREOF: BEGINNING at the Southwest corner of Lot No. 58 and Poplar Avenue; thence North along said Poplar Avenue twenty-five (25) feet to a post; thence East across Lot No. 57 one hundred fifty (150) feet to a public alley; thence South along said alley twenty-five (25) feet to the line of Lot No. 58; thence West along the line of Lot No. 58 one hundred fifty (150) feet to Poplar Avenue and the place of beginning. Being the Southern one-half of Lot No. 57.

BEING the same premises which James A. Curry by his deed dated April 25, 1944 recorded in the Recorder's Office for Clearfield County in Deed Book 359 at page 341 granted and conveyed to Roy H. Lutz and Grace M. Lutz.




