C O M P L A I N T

(1). The plaintiffs, Stephen G. Percy and Rhoda Percy, are individuals residing at 419 Thompson Street, Curwensville Borough, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania.

(2). The defendant, Betty J. Brunetti, is an individual residing at Grandview Avenue, Curwensville Borough, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania.

(3). On the 29th day of May, 1960, the plaintiffs were owners of a 1959 Ford 2-door Sedan bearing Pennsylvania license number F05033.

(4). On the 29th day of May, 1960, the defendant, Betty J. Brunetti, was the operator of a 1956 Pontiac 2-door Sedan bearing Pennsylvania license number A19835.

(5). At approximately 10:00 A.M. on the date aforesaid the plaintiff, Stephen G. Percy, was lawfully operating the plaintiffs' automobile in a southerly direction on the west side of Walnut Street at the intersection of Walnut Street and North Street in Curwensville Borough, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania.

(6). On the date and time aforesaid the defendant, Betty J. Brunetti, was operating the said Pontiac sedan in an easterly direction on North Street at the intersection of Walnut Street and

North Street in Curwensville Borough, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania.

(7). At the time, date and place aforesaid the said North Street was a side street and while no stop signs were posted thereon, vehicles traveling upon said street were required to stop at the intersection of said street with Walnut Street.

(8). (a) At the time, date and place aforesaid the said Walnut Street was a main or through street and no vehicles traveling thereon were required to stop at the intersection of Walnut and North Streets.

(b) Or in the event that said Walnut Street was not a main or through street the plaintiff vehicle had the right of way as the plaintiff's vehicle had proceeded into the intersection prior to the entry therein by the defendant's vehicle.

(9). At the time, date and place aforesaid the defendant, Betty J. Brunetti, while traveling east on North Street and approaching the intersection of Walnut and North Streets failed to stop at the said intersection and crossed into the plaintiffs' lane of traffic and violently struck the automobile of the plaintiffs' causing extensive damage thereto which is set forth more fully hereinafter.

(10). The defendant, Betty J. Brunetti, was negligent

(a). in failing to stop at an intersection.

(b). in failing to yield right of way.

(c). in attempting to enter a main street from a side street under such circumstances that a reasonable man would foresee possible harm to the plaintiffs' automobile which was traveling on the said main or through street.

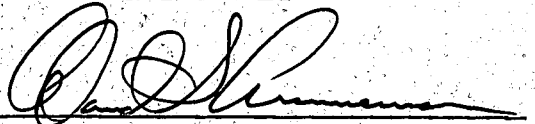
(d). in failing to observe the provisions

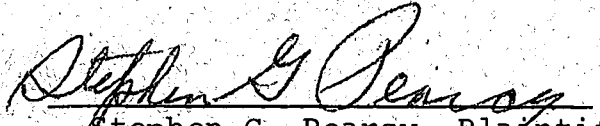
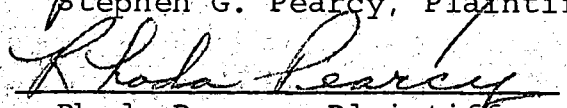
of the Pennsylvania Motor Vehicle Code.

(11). As a result of the aforesaid collision, the right side of the plaintiffs' automobile was severely damaged which necessitated extensive repairs in the amount of \$244.77, an itemized list which is marked "Exhibit A" which is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

WHEREFORE, the plaintiffs demand judgment against the defendant for \$244.77 and damages for delay.

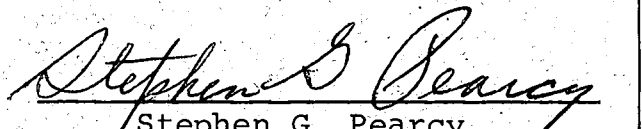
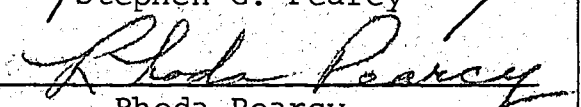
