PETITION

For Appropriation for Union Township Bridge. *11/18*

To the Grand Jurors Composing the Grand Inquest, inquiring in and for the body of the County of Clearfield at January Term A.D. 1874.

We the undersigned citizens of Union, Brady and Huston Townships in the County aforesaid:

Respectfully represent that a good substantial bridge has been erected across Anderson Creek, in the township of Union, during the past summer, under the Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of April, A.D. 1870, in the public road leading from Clearfield Town to Luthersburg and the Tunnel on the Low Grade Rail Road, at a cost of \$1,343,00 and that the ^{Citizens of the} Township of Union have raised by subscription the sum of \$543,00, and the County Commissioners, by the consent of a former Grand Jury and the Court have appropriated and paid the sum of \$500,00, leaving a balance due Messrs. W. H. Miller & Son the builders, the sum of \$300,00.

We further represent that the Bridge was highly necessary, and has been finished for over four months, and is being passed over hourly by the public. and that the citizens of Union township have already contributed the liberal sum of \$543,00, feel unable to give any more money toward a public improvement of this kind, and respectfully ask your honorable body to appropriate the further sum of \$300,00 out of the County Treasury toward the liquidation of the claim held by the builders against the bridge aforesaid.

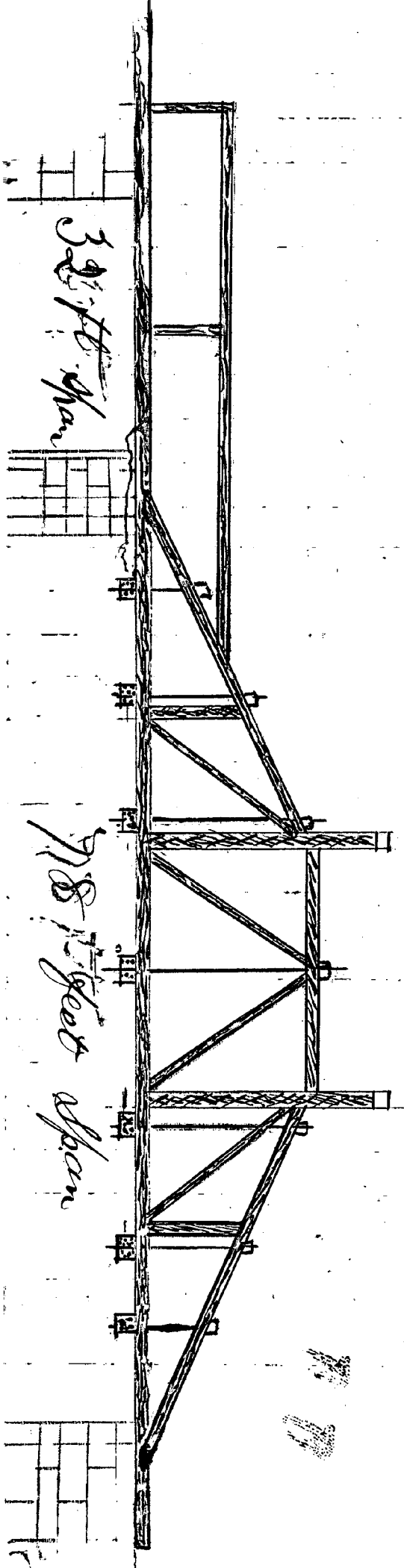
