To the Honorable the Judges of the Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace in and for the County of Gloucestershire.

The petition of William Marshall, of Lawrence Township in said County respectfully sheweth:- That on the 8th day of June 1871, a petition of sundry inhabitants of said Township was presented to said Court praying for the appointment of viewers to view and lay out a public Road leading from near Peter Wiggins to the public road at or near Mount Joy Church and School House in said Township - That your Honors were pleased to appoint Wm D. Bigler, Wm L. Richel and Richard Sharo Jr. said viewers. - That on the 8th day of Aug. 1871 said viewers proceeded to view and lay out said road, and presented their report of the same to this Honorable Court at Sept. Sess. 1871. This petition further represents that your petitioner is the owner of land through which said road is laid out, and that the viewers aforesaid made their report without assessing damages to your petitioner. He therefore prays that your Honors will appoint six disinterested persons to assess the same and make report to this Court at the next Term.

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the 20th day of March, A. D. 1872, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of ^{Wm Marshall} ~~sundry inhabitants~~ of the township of Lawrence, in said county, setting forth that ~~they~~ ^{he} labor under great inconvenience ~~for the want of a road or highway, leading from~~ and has sustained great damages by reason of a public road or high way leading from Peter McGeorge's to Mount Joy Church through lands of said Marshall

"Asseps damages as to Wm Marshall"

And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and ^{asseps damages on} ~~lay out~~ the same, according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

James Mitchell, J. A. Thompson and Wm Daniel

who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said road; and if any two of them agree that there is ^{Damages sustained by Petitioner} ~~occasion~~ for such road, they shall proceed to ^{asseps} ~~lay out~~ the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, ^{having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make} ~~setting forth the amount of damages sustained~~

~~report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, with reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.~~
