We the undersigned, persons appointed by the within Order of Court, to view, and locate the Road therein mentioned, Respectfully report: That having given notice of the time of the view of the road according to the Act of Assembly. And being all present at the time of the view of the said road. And having all been sworn or affirmed in pursuance of the said Order, we have viewed the following Road, and are of opinion that it is not necessary for a public or private road. Viz Beginning at the public Road on line of Henry Bickel's land, Thence through his land North three Degrees East forty one and a half perches, Thence through Isaac Thompson's land North forty three Degrees East seventy eight perches, North thirty three Degrees West twenty four perches, North fourteen and a half Degrees West eight and a half perches, North sixty eight Degrees East, twenty four perches, Thence through Robert Secch's land North sixty three and a half Degrees East, forty four perches, North eighty two Degrees East forty eight and six tenths perches Thence through Isaac Thomas's land North sixty four and a half Degrees East, fifty three and five tenths perches to the Turnpike near Isaac Thomas's
