Whereas, The present arrangement of The offices of The Prothonotary and Register and Recorder of This County is such, that The records of The various Courts kept therein are liable to be abstracted and destroyed; Thereby subjecting The incumbent of said offices and The parties litigating to great inconvenience, loss and damage.

And whereas, The Prothonotary and Register and Recorder, as well as all other parties interested should be protected, and The offices mentioned so arranged, and The Records, (including particularly The Continuance, Term, Execution, and Quarter Sessions Dockets) file papers, and other records of said Courts, so kept as to prevent any persons except Members of The Bar and their Clerks, and officers of The Court from making any personal examination of The same.

It is Therefore, Resolved, by "The Clearfield Bar Association" That The President of said Association be requested to bring This matter to The notice of The President Judge of The various Courts of Clearfield County, for The purpose of obtaining such order as The case may require, so that The Continuance, Term, Execution, and Quarter Sessions Dockets, file papers, Deed Books, Will Books, Miscellaneous Dockets, and other records of said Courts, may not be open to The inspection of any one except Members of The Bar, and their clerks, and officers of The Court.
