



C O M P L A I N T

NOW, this 21st day of July, 1961, comes the Plaintiff, Pennsylvania Electric Company, a corporation, by its attorneys Kelley, Johnston & Cimino, and brings this action of trespass against the defendant, Norman G. Russin, to recover the sum of One Hundred Forty and 74/100 (\$140.74) Dollars, with interest from May 13, 1960, which is justly due said plaintiff in a cause of action of which the following is a statement:

1. The plaintiff is a corporation with its principal place of business in Pennsylvania which generates electricity and distributes it by wires and poles in Clearfield County, Pennsylvania.

2. That defendant is an individual and was a former resident of Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, but since the damage hereinafter set forth he has removed from the State of Pennsylvania to the State of Ohio and refuses to answer mail in connection with the damage.

3. That on May 13, 1960 said defendant was driving his Plymouth automobile and at a point known as Cross Keys in Woodward Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, drove off the road and broke off an electric pole No. 53103.

4. That said defendant at the time and place above stated, negligently operated his Plymouth automobile without regard to the property of the said Plaintiff which was erected on the side and off the traveled part of the road.

5. The Defendant's negligence was in not observing the boundaries of the road and was in permitting his car to go off the road and strike a pole which was owned by the Bell Telephone Company and upon which electric line facilities of the Plaintiff were installed.

6. By reason of the said collision and the total destruction of the pole, it was necessary to have a crew remove and re-install the facilities of the Plaintiff which were installed on the pole.

7. That the total cost of removing and re-installing the facilities amounted to One Hundred Forty and 74/100 (\$140.74) Dollars as fully set forth in the itemized statement attached hereto, marked Exhibit "A" and made an integral part hereof.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff claims by reason of said collision it has suffered damages to the extent of One Hundred Forty and 74/100 (\$140.74) Dollars and requests interest thereon from May 13, 1960.

HENCE, this suit.
