Road Viewers' Report.

CLEARFIELD COUNTY, SS:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the 15 day of Nov, A. D. 1872, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of Lawrence, in said county, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience ~~for the want of a road or highway, leading from to Rockton a part of which is~~ ^{for the want of a road long since ~~closed~~ out from Clearf.} ~~brotherhood and inconvenient to wit beginning at or near Leonard Ogden's and extending to the foot of the big hill~~ And asking is vacated supplied by a new road beginning at the foot of the big hill near where branch of Moose Creek crosses said old road thence down said Creek to intersect the road leading from Clearf Borough to ~~Clearf~~ ^{Siunamahoning}

Report as to damages &c.

And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view ^{vacate} and lay out the same, according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

W. D. Bigler, Matt. Ogden & Geo. Carter

who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said road; and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such road, ^{change of} they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make

report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, with reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.

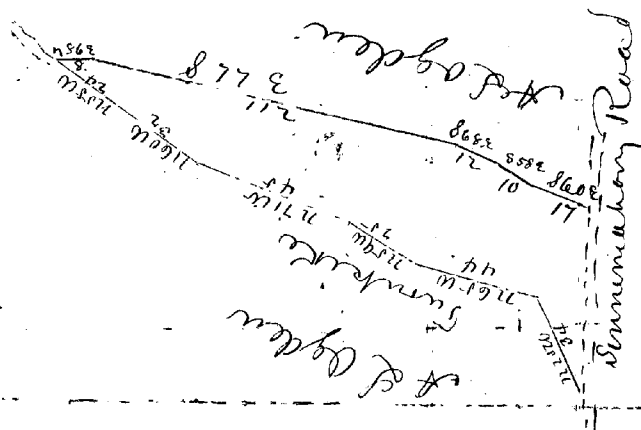

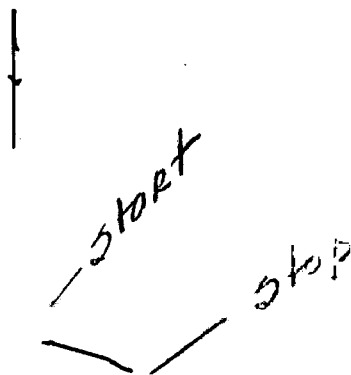

We the undersigned here appearing at the
above order of court to run & lay out the road therein mentioned
respectfully report: That a day was appointed for said
view by printed notices as required by Act of Assembly
and the time of said view was continued until
the 30th March 1843, on which day we met at the
place appointed having been all duly affirmed
we went upon the ground proposed for said view
& having examined the same we do report for public
use the following road: Beginning where the old
Turnpike crosses Mene Creek at the foot of the big hill
thence North 80 degrees East 8 perches, thence South 77
degrees East ^{11 1/2} ~~70~~ perches thence South 65 degrees East 12
perches ^(S 58 E 10 P) thence South 69 degrees East 17 perches to the
Sunnamahy Road, a draft of plot whereof is hereto an-
nexed, all of which we report as necessary for a
public road: and we further report no damages
from said view. We also report the location of
the old Turnpike between the foot of the hill above
mentioned & the Sunnamahy Road as follow: Beg. at the Bnd,
thence S 55 E 24 perches, thence S 60 E 32 perches, S 71 E 45
perches ^{S 54 E 25 P}, S 65 E 44 perches, S 25 E 34 perches, to Sunnamahy
Road.
