of Bridge across Clearfield Creek

CLEARFIELD COUNTY, SS:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the 6th day of June, A. D., 1870, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of Boggs, in the said county, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a ~~road or highway~~, leading from

about three miles East of Clearfield Borough*

And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and ^{Report} lay out the same, according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint Sam. H. McCloskey, Sam. P. Wilson and Jacob Pearce who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said ^{Bridge} ~~road~~, and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such ^{Bridge} ~~road~~ they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners, as may be, having respect for the best ground for a ^{Bridge} ~~road~~, and the

road leading from Clearfield to the Old Erie
turnpike ~~is~~ near the premises of ~~David~~
Adams, in ~~Rego~~ township, crosses the said
Creek. at the residence of Abraham Litz in
Lawrence Township is not necessary and that the
erecting of such a Bridge would be attended with more
expense than would justify the the County in paying for
the amount of travel on the said Road.
