We the undersigned viewers appointed at Sept term to view a site for a Bridge across the west branch of the Susquehanna River at Gallos harbour do report that we have examined the ground proposed for said bridge on the nineteenth day of Dec 1871 and after being duly sworn according to law do agree that in consideration of there being no road to that point on the Gerard side of the River that in our judgement a Bridge at that point is not necessary at present believing as we do that some other point would suit the general community better

And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and ~~lay out~~ ^{Report} the same, according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

John Moulson, Lawrence Hood and Alex^r. Murray

who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said ~~road~~ ^{Bridge} and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such ~~road~~ ^{Bridge}, they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, ~~having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property;~~ and shall make report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or ~~private road~~ ^{Bridge}, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, ~~with reference to the improvements through which it may pass,~~ to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.
