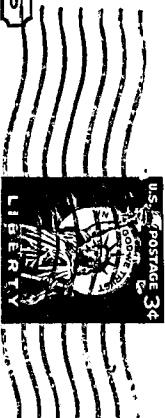

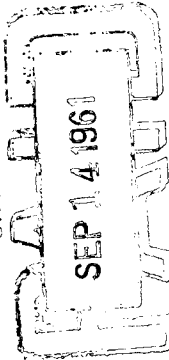

C O M P L A I N T

(1). The name of the Plaintiff is Patricia B. Lanier, a resident of South Second Street, in the Borough of Clearfield, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania.

(2). The name of the Defendant is Alonza Lanier, a resident of 1583 Franklin Street, in the City of Johnstown, Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

(3). The Plaintiff and Defendant have resided in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania for a period in excess of one (1) year prior to the filing of this Complaint.

(4). The Plaintiff and Defendant were lawfully joined in marriage by Reverend Ralph Newell on the 8th day of February, 1960, at Kittaning, in the State of Pennsylvania.

(5). The Plaintiff is 35 years of age and is a housewife. The Defendant is 40 years of age and is a sheet metal worker.

(6). In violation of his marriage vows and the laws of this Commonwealth, the Defendant, Alonza Lanier, did offer such indignities to the person of the Plaintiff as to render her condition intolerable and life burdensome.

(7). There is no collusion between the Plaintiff and the Defendant.

(8). There has been no prior action for divorce or annulment of marriage by either of the parties in this or any other action.

(9). There have been no children born of this marriage.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff prays that a Decree be entered by your Honorable Court divorcing the Plaintiff from the bonds of matrimony between her and the Defendant.

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

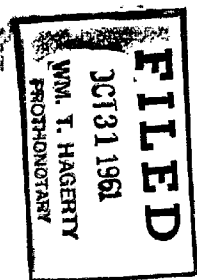

Now comes your Petitioner, Patricia Lanier, and avers as follows:

(1). The name of your Petitioner is Patricia Lanier, a resident of the Borough of Clearfield, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania.

(2). The name of the Defendant is Alonza Lanier, a resident of the City of Johnstown, Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

(3). On or about the day of August, 1961, your Petitioner filed an action in divorce against the Defendant, her husband, and has had a copy duly served upon the Defendant.

(4). Petitioner has no funds whatsoever.

(5). Petitioner will be put to considerable expense in the preparation of her case in the employment of counsel and payment of costs in these proceedings; said expenses approximate \$435.00, being as follows:

(8). Petitioner and Defendant separated on or about the 22 day of July, 1961, and Defendant has refused to contribute to the support and maintenance of your Petitioner since on or about the 22 day of July, 1961.

(9). Defendant is in a position to pay alimony pendente lite and expenses of your Petitioner by reason of his gainful employment as a sheet metal worker at an average monthly salary of \$700.00.

WHEREFORE, your Petitioner prays this Honorable Court to grant a rule upon the Defendant to show cause why he should not pay to the Plaintiff alimony, pendente lite, counsel fees and expenses.

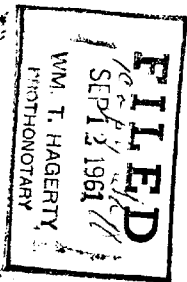
