Road Viewers' Report.

CLEARFIELD COUNTY, SS:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the 7 day of June, A. D. 1873, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of Chest, in said county, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a road or highway, leading from the public road at or near John McCord's to intersect the public Road leading from Newburg to J. M. Geckens

Report as to damages &c

And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same, according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

John McCord, John McQuilken & Lawrence Killian

who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said road; and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make

report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, with reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.

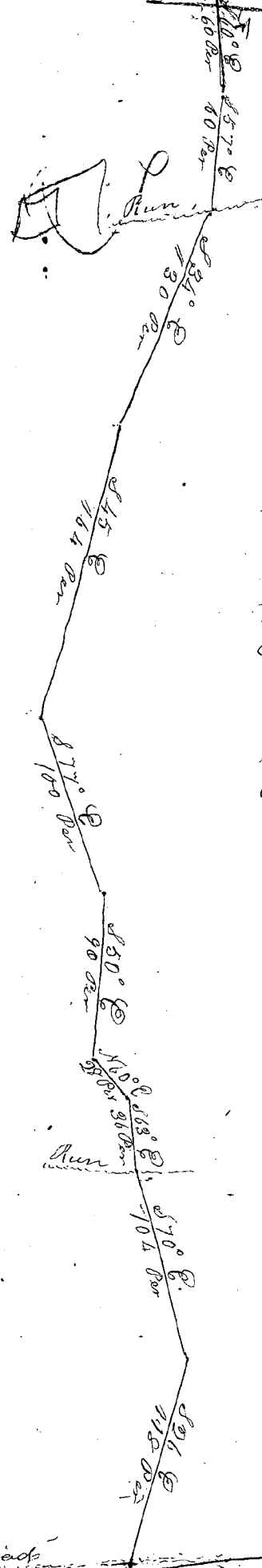

We the undersigned appointed in the foregoing order as viewers having given due notice according to law by written advertisements of the time & place of meeting, & having been first duly & severally sworn or affirmed, did thereupon on the 15th day of August proceed to view the Road mentioned in the said order as therein directed, all being present upon the ground, & having viewed the same we have laid out and return as necessary for public use the following road, to wit; Beginning at point on the Newburg & McQuilken Road called the Burnt Cabin & thence South 60 degrees East 60 perches thence South 57 degrees East 60 perches thence South 34 degrees East 130 perches thence South 45 degrees East 164 perches thence South 77 degrees East 100 perches thence South 50 degrees East 90 perches thence North 60 degrees East 28 perches thence South 63 degrees East 36 perches to a Run thence South 70 degrees East 104 perches thence South 26 degrees East 118 perches to the Road near John McQuilken
