Road Viewers' Report.

CLEARFIELD COUNTY, SS:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the 14th day of March, A. D. 1873, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of Brady, in said county, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a road or highway, leading from the public road on lands of McClure and Yohe at a point about five rods east of the fork's of the two main streams on said land, to intersect the public road south of George Hartsfelts saw mill —
Report as to damages &c.

And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same, according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

Geo. C. Kirk, M. H. Sutherland and J. A. Shaffer

who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said road; and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, with reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.

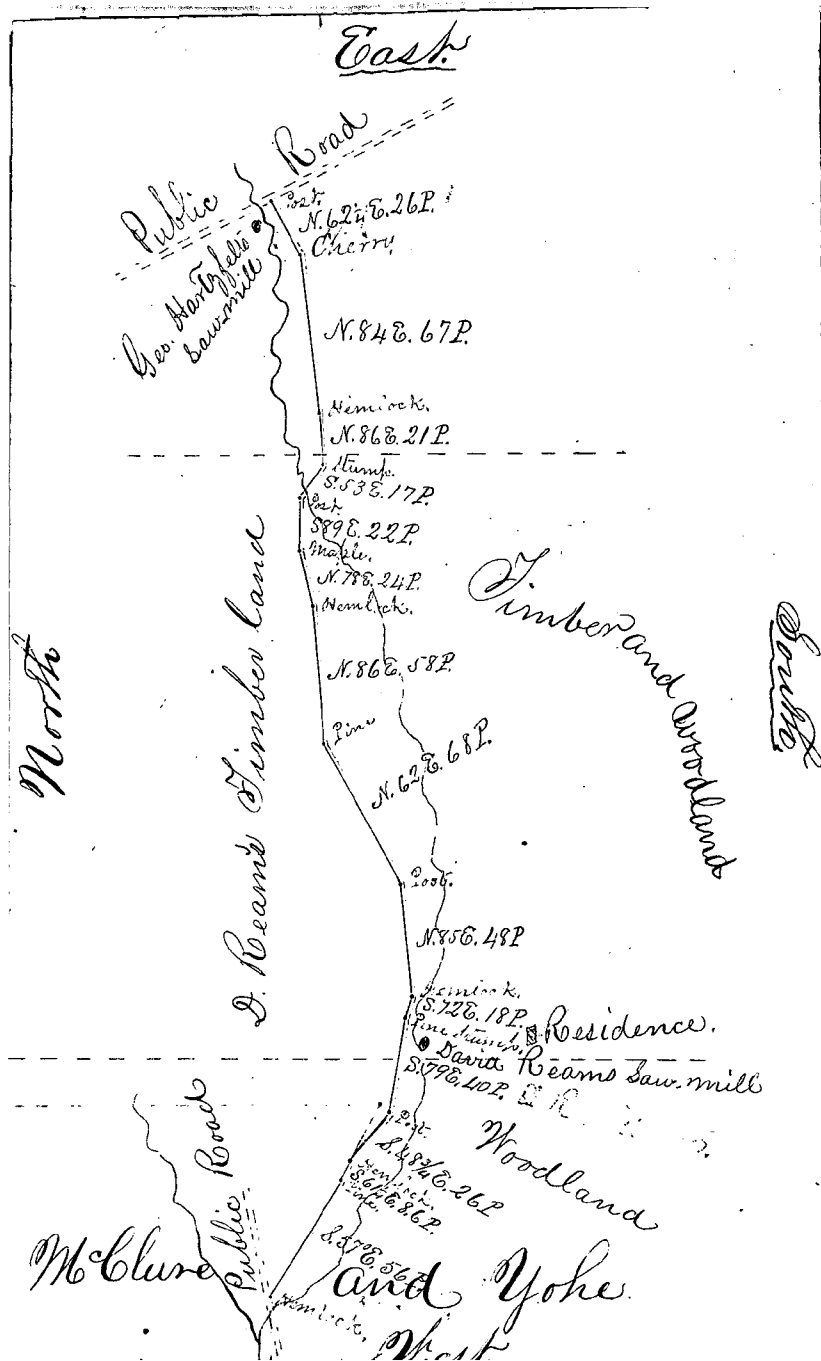

To the Honorable, the Judges within named,
We the undersigned, appointed by the annexed,
order do report; That in pursuance thereof, af-
ter having been severally duly sworn accor-
ding to law, all the viewers appointed by said
order, viewed the ground proposed for the within
mentioned road, and we do agree that there
is occasion for a road as desired by the petiti-
oners, and that the same is necessary for a
public road. And having had respect to the
best ground and shortest distance for such road,
we have laid out in such manner, as in our
opinion, shall do the least injury to private
property, and as far as practicable agreeably
to the desire of the petitioners, and do return
for public use the following described road, to
wit: Beginning at a Hemlock, at the public
road on lands of McClure & Yohe, east of
the forks of the two main streams; Thence
South 57° East, through lands of said McClure
and Yohe, fifty six perches to a pine; Thence
South 61½° East, eight and six tenths perches to a He-
mlock; Thence South 48½° East, twenty six perches
to a Post; Thence South 79° East, partly through land
of said McClure and Yohe and partly through
land of David Ream, forty perches to a pine
stump; Thence South 72° East, eighteen perches
to a Hemlock; Thence North 85° East, forty eight
perches to a post; Thence North 62° East, sixty eight
perches to a pine; Thence North 86° East, fifty ei-
ght perches to a Hemlock; Thence North 78° East,
twenty four perches to a Maple; Thence South
89° East, twenty two perches to a Post; Thence South
53° East, seventeen perches to a stump; Thence North
86° East, twenty one perches to a Hemlock; Thence
North 84° East, sixty seven perches to a Cherry
on land of Geo. Hartzfelt; Thence North 62½°
East, 26 perches to a Post, at public road, south
of, and near Hartzfelt's Saw-mill. Said road
being at an elevation not exceeding five deg-
rees. The undersigned further report that
they have made inquiry as to damages, and
find that no damages result to any one,
through whose land the road passes, We
further report, that before the said view, pub-
lic notice of the time and place of the
meeting of the viewers was given by advertise-
ments put up at three of the most public plac-
es in the vicinity - Ten days before said mee-
ting. We annex a plot or draft of said road
laid out, stating the courses and distances,
and noticing briefly the improvements the-
rough which the same passes.

of May A.D. 1873.

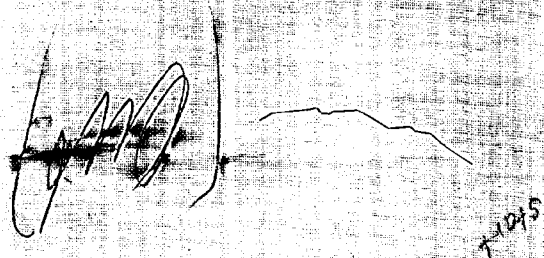
