Road Viewers' Report.

CLEARFIELD COUNTY, SS:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the 7th day of June, A. D. 1873, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of Knox, in said county, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a road or highway, leading from the Village of New Millport to Erhards Saw mill

Report as to Damages &c

And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same, according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

Thos W. Moore - Will Wise and Jas S. Williams

who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said road; and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, with reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.

We the undersigned Viewers appointed by the foregoing Order of Court to view the road therein described, Do Report, That in pursuance of said appointment after first having given notice of the time & place of said view by Printed & written advertisements put up according to Law and we also having given notice to the Owners & occupants of lands through which said road was intended to pass of the same. We all met and after being duly Affirmed according to Law We have viewed said road & do return for Public use the following road Viz: Beginning at a Public road near Erhard's Sawmill, thence South 21 Degrees West, 8 Perches Cross Little Cleaveland Creek and same corner at $13\frac{1}{2}$ Perches to a Pine Stump, South 39 Degrees West $4\frac{8}{10}$ Perches to a Small Beech, South $64\frac{1}{2}$ Degrees West 5 Perches to a Beech, South 73 Degrees West, 8 Perches to a Hemlock, South 83 Degrees West $71\frac{9}{10}$ Perches to a Hemlock South 65 deg: West 32 Per² to a Post, South 45 deg. West, 12 Perches to Hemk, South $39\frac{1}{2}$ deg² West, 24 Per to a Hem, South 81. degrees West, 11 Per². to Hemk, South 68 Degrees West, 32 Perches to Beech, South $77\frac{1}{2}$ Degrees West, 15 Per² to Hemk, South 86 deg West $15\frac{1}{2}$ Per² to Hemk, North 75 Degrees West, $14\frac{1}{2}$ Perches to Beech, South 80 deg West, 20 Per Post on line of Bloom & Arnold - thence North 84 deg.
