Road Viewers' Report.

CLEARFIELD COUNTY, SS:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, held at Clearfield and for said county, on the 14th day of March, A. D. 1873 the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the to of Penn. Sargerson et al, in said county, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of ~~a road or highway~~ leading from a Bridge across Susquehanna River at or near Hogs Mill

And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and ^{Report} lay out the same, according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and

Sam. Hidenwire, Wm. F. Johnston and James Wiley who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said ^{Bridge} ~~road~~; and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such ^{Bridge} ~~road~~, they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agree ^{and report} the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a ^{Bridge} ~~road~~, at the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the ^{Bridge} ~~road~~ necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot of the same, and the courses and distances, with reference to the landmarks through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.
