To The Honorable, The Judges within named;
We the undersigned, appointed by The annexed
order do report; That in pursuance thereof,
after having been severally duly sworn accord-
ing to law, all The viewers appointed by said
order, viewed The ground proposed for The with-
in mentioned road, and we do agree That There
is occasion for The same as desired by The petiti-
oners, and That The same is necessary for a public
road. And having had respect to The shortest
distance and The best ground for such road, we
have laid out in such manner as shall, in our opin-
ion, do The least injury to private property, and as far as
practicable agreeably to The desire of The petitioners, and
do return for public use The following described road,
To wit:— Beginning at a Post, near Joseph La Roche's
Thence North 61° East, on lands of Chat. Brown, forty five
en perches to a Post in Public Road leading to Hickory,
said road being at an elevation not exceeding five degrees,
We further report That we have made inquiry as to dam-
ages, and find That no damages result to Chat. Brown
Through whose land said road passes, from opening The
same, That before The said view public notice of The
time and place of The meeting of said viewers was given
by advertisements put up at Three of The most public pl-
aces in The vicinity— ten days before said meeting,
and we annex a plot or draft of said road laid out,
stating The courses and distances, and noticing
briefly the improvements Through which The

Road Viewers' Report.

CLEARFIELD COUNTY, SS:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the *Seventh* day of *June*, A. D. 187*3*, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of *Union*, in said county, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a road or highway, leading from *at or near Joseph La-*
=rocks to the Hickory road
Report as to Damages &c

And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same, according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

Geo. C. Kirk David Kelly and Joseph Sines
who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said road; and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make

report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, with reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.
