Road Viewers' Report.

CLEARFIELD COUNTY, SS:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the 7th day of June, A. D. 1875, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of Knox, in said county, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a road or highway, leading from the public road at or near the end of Samuel Reed's lane to the public road of or near James Jackson Saw Mill

Report as to Damages

And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same, according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

Henry Wright - One, Withers - One, David Smith

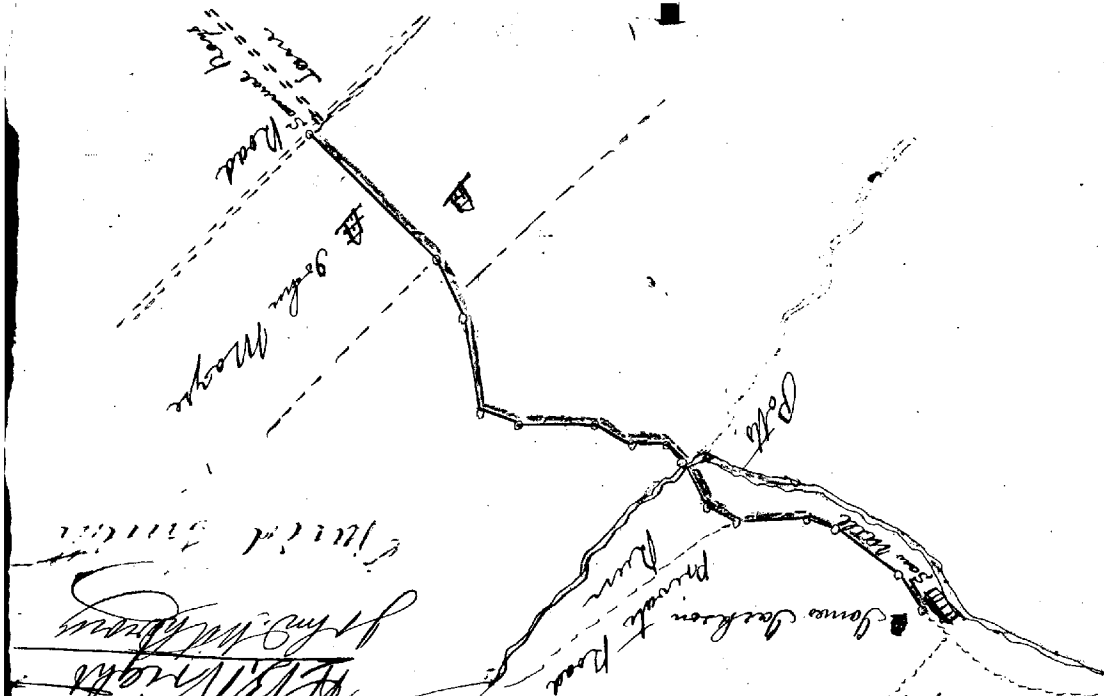
who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said road; and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, with reference to the improvement through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law

We the persons appointed by the within order of Court to view and lay out the Road from Mountain Spring first seen approved according to law, do Report that there was no damage laid in, and that there was in deep note given of the same, that at the same time the ground for said Road, that in pursuance of said Order we have viewed, laid out and returned for public use, the following Road, to wit, Beginning near James Reed Lane South 54 West one hundred and fourteen feet along John May's line left side, thence South 16 West thirty eight feet, thence West thirty feet, thence South 36 West thirty four feet, thence South 8 West forty eight feet, thence South 23 West thirty four feet, thence South 10 West twenty five feet, thence South 40 West twelve feet to Pole Run, thence South 58 West thirty feet, thence South 31 West twenty feet, thence South 9 West forty feet, thence South 45 West thirty feet, thence South 63 West twenty four feet to Jackson Saw Mill, a draft of which is herewith annexed.
