Road Viewers' Report

CLEARFIELD COUNTY, SS:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the 3rd day of June, A. D. 1873, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of Bradford, in said county, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of ~~a road or highway, leading from~~ A vacation of a part

of a Road Leading from D. Forcey's to the Millstone School House and confirmed at Sept. 28, 1871 -
Beginning at the Forcey & Dale Road thence North 30° East 24 perches and so on to the Bald Hills Road

And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and ^{vacate} ~~lay out~~ the same, according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

Thos W. Moore, M. J. Irwin and Henry Owens

who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said road; and if any two of them agree that there is ^{no} occasion for such road, they shall proceed to ^{vacate} ~~lay out~~ the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make

report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same ~~unnecessary~~ for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, with reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.

To the Honorable Judges of the Court of Quarter
Sessions of the County of Bradford,

We the undersigned Viewers appointed
by the foregoing Order of Court to View the road there
in described, do Report, that in pursuance of
said appointment, after having given ~~over~~ ^{more} than
five days notice of the same by advertisements put up
according to Law of the time & place of said view. We
all met and being first duly affirmed, did pro-
ceed to view said road beginning at the Percy
and Dale road on land of Mrs Angeline Percy. Thence
through land of said Angeline Percy and land of
William Percy, North three degrees East Two Hun-
dred and thirty seven Perches to the Bald Hills road
a Plot or Draft of which we hereto annex, and we
are of the opinion that said road was very im-
prudently located and will be very expensive to make
as a considerable portion of it passes over very swampy
ground, and it is our opinion that the roads
now used are on better ground and will amply
suffice if put in ^{good} repair, all the necessities of the
travelling public. We therefore on behalf of the cit-
izens of Bradford Township would recommend
that the ~~of~~ ^{the same} said road be, and is hereby declared
Vacated, all of which we submit.
