Road Viewers' Report.

CLEARFIELD COUNTY, SS:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the 7th day of June, A. D. 1873, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of Burnside, in said county, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a road or highway, leading from Township road near Joseph Brothess to the township road at or near Gideon Kierports:

Report as to damages &c

And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same, according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

Sho. W. Moore, J. B. Young and Sho. Thompson

who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said road; and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make

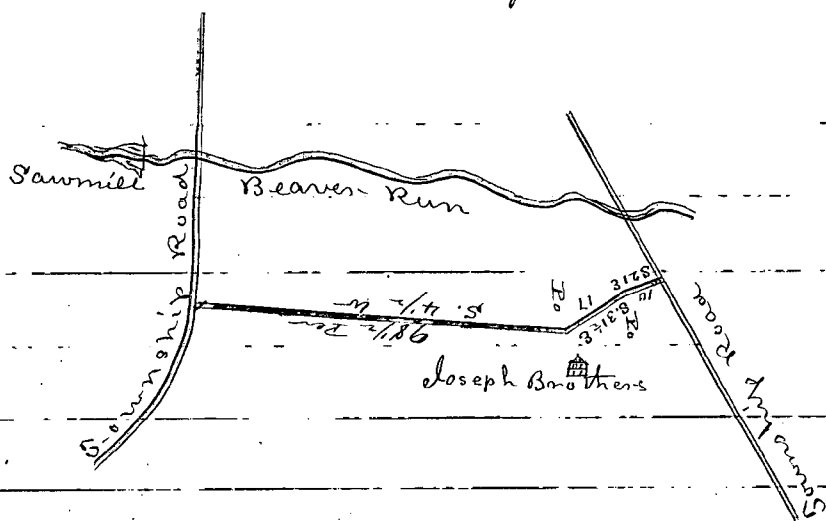
report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, with reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.

We the undersigned Viewers appointed by the
foregoing Order of Court to View the Road therein described
Do Report, that in pursuance of said appointment after hav-
ing given due notice of the time & place of said View by written
& printed Advertisements put up according to Law we all met
and after being duly Sworn & affirmed, did proceed
to examine the ground for said road, have Viewed
laid out & do return for Public use the following
Road Viz, Beginning at the Township road at a Post
near Joseph Brothers thence South 21 deg East Ten (10) Perches
to a Post thence South thirty one & one half degrees East, Seventeen Perches to
a Post near Brothers Barn, thence South Four & one half degrees west
ninety eight & one half Perches to a Post on Township road near
Gideon Kinsports. A. Plot in Draft of which we here-
unto annex. (No Damages are claimed by any one)
