To the Honorable Judges of the Court of Common
Pleas of Clearfield County, now holding a
Court of General Quarter Sessions in and for
Said County.

We the undersigned Viewers - ap-
pointed by the foregoing Order of Court to View the
Site for a Bridge across the Little Clearfield Creek
at the mouth thereof. Submit the following re-
port, Viz: That we (after first having given notice
thereof according to Law of the time & place of said
view) all met and being duly affirmed
we have viewed the site for said Bridge and
have ascertained the length of span required
to be 120 feet; and that a good and Substantial
Bridge has been erected of the aforesaid length &
12 feet width by the Supervisors of Lawrence &
Boggs townships, and that such a Bridge
is very necessary at this point; and believing
that the expense incurred in the erection of said
Bridge viz (1000) Dollars would be more than
the adjoining townships could reasonably be
expected to bear, we would recommend that
the County assist them therein.
