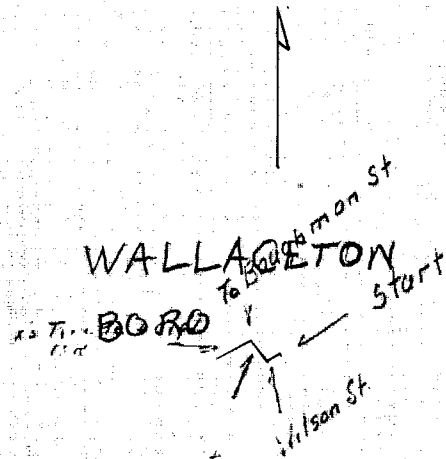

Road Viewers' Report.

CLEARFIELD COUNTY, SS:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the 13th day of June, A. D. 1874; before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of Boggs, in said county, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a ^{change of} road or highway, leading from the Turnpike at Wallaceston to the old turnpike at Crannandale, which is ~~the~~ between the east line at Wallaceston to the road that leads to the mill of Hon. J. B. McNally.

Report as to damages

And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view ^{vacate} and lay out the same, according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

John L. Cuttle John Beish And Wilson Hoover

who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said road; and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to ^{vacate and} lay out the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make

report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, with reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.

To the Honorable the Judges of the Court of Quarter Sessions of the
County of Clearfield, now holding a Court of General Sessions of the Peace
at September Term 1874.

The undersigned viewers appointed to view and vacate a
portion of the Township road between the east line of Wallacetown and the town
road leading to McErmallys Saw Mill. Respectfully report, that having given
due and timely notice of the time and place of the meeting of the viewers, by ad-
vertisements put up in public places in said Borough & township of Boggs for more than
five days before the meeting of the viewers, that they went upon the ground
proposed for vacation, and being first duly sworn or affirmed, proceeded to vacate
the township road, where "Wilson Street" as laid out in the Bow of Wallacetown inter-
sects said road, to where said township road intersects the road leading to Hon L. B.
McErmallys Mill, and have substituted therefor, Wilson Street, sixty feet in width bearing
South 66° West, 357 feet, thence South 38° West by Clearfield Street 380 feet, thence
by same North 29° West 420 feet to Baughman Street and thence by Baughman
Street Eleven Hundred and twenty five feet to intersection of Town Road leading to
Hon J. B. McErmallys mill - they therefore recommend the vacation of said township
road between said points being at present laid out across the building lots, to wit
said road bears North 87° West and feet in length, and the aforesaid
streets be substituted therefor, as we believe said change to be necessary, No
