Road Viewers' Report.

CLEARFIELD COUNTY, SS:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the eighth day of June, A. D. 1874, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of Union, in said county, setting forth that ~~they labor under great inconvenience~~ ^{a certain} ~~for the want of a~~ road or highway, leading from Thomas Brockbanks to the ~~public~~ road leading to Henry Pentz has become useless inconvenient and burthensome to the inhabitants of said Township

And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same, according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

Thos. H. Moore - David Kelly and Henry Bailey who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said ^{vacation} ~~road~~; and if any two of them agree that there is ^{an} occasion for such road, they shall proceed to ^{vacate} ~~lay out~~ the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, with reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.

bed. Do Report that in pursuance of said
appointment after having first given due
notice by written & printed advertisements put
up according to Law of the times & place of said
view we all met and having been duly
sworn & affirmed we did proceed to view
the same by the following courses & distances
Viz Beginning at a Point near T. J. Boyer
Sawmill, thence North 53 degrees west 16
Perches North 70 degrees West 20 Perches
North 72 degrees West 22 Perches to John
Hollipeter Corner. Thence west on line of Hollipeter
and the Brookbank, 86 1/2 Perches thence North
82 degrees west 9 Perches to the Turnpike near
the House of Thomas Broadbent, which said
road has gone entirely out of repair and
in our opinion is useless & should be vacated
which we submit together with a Plot & Draft
of the same

State The above order calls for vacation of road from T
Broadbent to H Perito Road. But we find by the record
of the return of said road that it was only laid out to the saw-
mill of David Hurn (now T. J. Boyer)
