Road Viewers' Report.

CLEARFIELD COUNTY, SS:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the 17 day of Janf., A. D. 1874, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of Boggs, in said county, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a road or highway, leading from

*Leading from near the
Blue Ball to Kepharts Hill*

And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and ^{vacate} ~~lay out~~ the same, according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

J. Dimeling - David Meese & Andy Kephart

who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said road; and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to ^{vacate} ~~lay out~~ the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make

report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, with reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.

To the Honorable the Judges of the Court of Quarter Sessions of the County of Clearfield at June Sessions 1874.

The undersigned viewers appointed by your Honors, in and by virtue of the annexed order, Respectfully Report:

That after giving due timely and legal notice of the time and place of meeting of the viewers, and been first duly sworn they met upon the ground, and proceeded to view the road leading from Blue Ball in Boggs Township to Kepharts Hill in Decatur, proposed for vacation, and recommend, that that portion of the Township Road leading from Blue Ball to the Erie Turnpike having the following courses & distances viz. Beginning at the longest Turnpike thence $S 88^{\circ} W$ - 18 per to Laurel Run, $S 6^{\circ} W$. 6 per, $S 18^{\circ} W$ 9 per, $S 72^{\circ} W$. 44 per, $S 17^{\circ} W$ 14 per to Erie Turnpike, be vacated, in all 91 perches, (thence $S 88^{\circ} W$. by Turnpike to Erie, 48 per to Township Road) and by said Township Road $S 65^{\circ} W$. 24 perches, thence $S 72^{\circ} W$. 12 per and all of which road from the Mine Road to Gopi's fence we recommend for vacation, and should the powers of the Court not be extended for the granting a Private Road to Jonas Peters from the Erie Turnpike to the Mine Road then we recommend the whole of said Road for vacation absolutely, a plot or draught of which is hereto attached,
