To the Honorable the Judges within
Manner.

We the undersigned person appointed
by the within order of Court, to view and
lay out the Road therein mentioned—
respectfully report, that having been present
at the view, of the ground proposed for such
road, and having been all first severally
sworn, in pursuance of the said order,
we have received and laid out, and do
return for public use the following road
to wit: Beginning at the Western end
of Edward Street in Chester Hill. Thence
through land of J. F. Steiner South-
56° 45" West one thousand seven hundred
and fifty feet. Thence in same bear-
ing across Road Twenty feet. Thence on
same bearing through land of

Two hundred feet. Thence on same
bearing across Union Ave. Road. one
hundred feet. Thence on same bearing—
through land of J. Peters, one thousand
four hundred feet. Thence by a ~~ten~~ 18° curve
to Road, through land of J. Peters. Two
hundred feet. Thence in old Road by same
course for twenty feet. Thence in old Road
South 89° West. Eight hundred feet—
Thence in old Road by a 9° curve to left
for seven hundred and eighty five feet.

Thence in old Road South $46^{\circ} 20''$ West
Two hundred feet. Thence through corner of
Gearhart South $46^{\circ} 20''$ West. Eight
hundred and eighty feet. Thence by a 6" beam
to the right, for three hundred and twenty (320)
feet. Thence South $68^{\circ} 30''$ West. At one hun-
dred feet to a point in the old Road at
the foot of the Gearhart hill.

A draft or plot of the road, with the
improvements through which the same pass-
es, is hereto annexed.

We further report, that we have assessed
damages, to the parties through whose property
the above named road runs, as follows to-
wiz:

To J. H. Steiner the sum of two hun-
dred and sixty eight dollars & eighty cents.

To Patrick Holton the sum of thirty dollars.

" J. Peter the sum of two hundred and
ten dollars.

Road Viewers' Report.

CLEARFIELD COUNTY, SS:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, held at Clearfield, in and for said county; on the 28th day of September, A. D. 1874, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of Keokuk, in said county, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a ^{change of} road or highway, leading from Philipsburg to Osceola to wit - from Edward Street Commonly Called Chesterville to a point on the Osceola Road above the Steiner Hill

Report as to Damages &c

And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view ^{vacate & supply} ~~and lay out~~ the same, according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

L. G. Lingle Alexander Luke & Richard Hughes who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said road; and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to ^{change of} ~~lay out~~ ^{new vacate &} the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, with reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.

To the Honorable the Judges of the Court of
Quarter Sessions of the Peace in and for
the County of Glenfield:

The petition of the Undersigned inhabit-
ants of Deane Township in said County
respectfully sheweth: That a road
has long since been laid out from Phil-
ipsburg to Ocedow passing through Ches-
ter hill and Steiners station on the
I. & C. Railroad; that a portion of said
road is dangerous to persons riding
and driving and to cattle from its
close proximity to the said Railroad,
that a shorter line, a better grade, and
a greater security to persons and prop-
erty can be had by vacating a small
portion of said road, and relaying
the same. Your petitioners therefore
pray the Court to appoint viewers to
locate and lay out a portion of said
road, from Edward Street in the vil-
lage commonly called Chester hill
to a point on the said Ocedow road
and above the Steiners hill; And also
to vacate such portion of the old road
as will be rendered useless thereby.
