We, the undersigned persons appointed by the within Order of Court to view and lay out the road therein mentioned, respectfully report that: having given notice of the time and place of meeting, according to the Act of Assembly, and being all present at the view of the ground proposed for the said road, and being all sworn in pursuance of the said Order, we have viewed, and laid out, and do return, the following Road viz. Beginning at the Township Road, where the Ip Road to James R. Blome intersects, Thence through land of Aaron Wise, South twenty five degrees west, twenty six perches, South five degrees west, twenty two perches, Thence through land of John Mays, South thirty four and a half degrees west nineteen perches, Thence South fifty three degrees west, fourteen perches, Thence South forty six and a half degrees west eighteen perches, South thirty two degrees west, ten perches, South thirteen degrees west, eleven perches, South two and a half degrees west, twenty one perches, Thence South five degrees East fourteen & three tenths perches, South seven degrees west, thirty six perches, Thence through land of Samuel Bryan South fifty two and a half west, twenty seven and five tenths perches, South thirty eight west, seventeen perches, Thence through land of Samuel Wray South twenty six degrees west, twenty four perches, South eighteen and a half degrees west, fifteen perches, South five degrees west, twenty four perches, South thirty degrees west, six perches, South ten degrees west, twenty three perches, to the Public Road, a Draft whereof is herewith annexed.

Which said Road as aforesaid laid out, we are of opinion is necessary for a Public Road, and further we are of opinion that no parties through whose land the aforesaid road passes, is entitled to any damage.

Road Viewers' Report.

CLEARFIELD COUNTY, SS:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the 16 day of October, A. D. 1874, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of Knox, in said county, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a road or highway, leading from a point at or near

the end of Snyder's lane to at or near
James B. Bloomer in Knox
Township

Report as to damages &c

And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same, according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

John S. Little, Conrad Baker & R. Caldwell

who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said road; and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, with reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.
