Hoover's saw mill to a point near Hummel's saw
mill in graham Township Clearfield Co. Pennsylvania
which was accordingly done and the said viewers so appoin-
ted did view lay out and return for public use a road
beginning at a point near Hoover's saw mill to a point on
public road near Hummel's saw mill which was an
due consideration approved of and confirmed by the court;
that the said road not yet having been opened and it
appearing to your petitioners to be useless and if
opened would become burdensome — they therefore
pray the court to appoint persons not residing
on or owning land on the route of the said road
to view the same and make report according to law

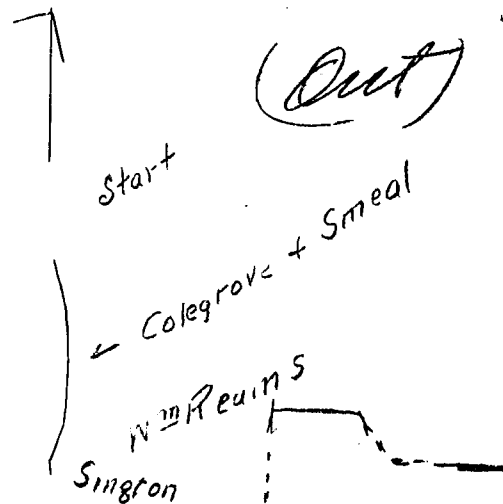
