We the undersigned persons appointed
by the within order of Court, to view
and lay out the Road therein mentioned,
respectfully report, that having been pre-
sent at the view of the ground proposed
for such road, and having been all first
severally sworn, in pursuance of the said
order, we have viewed and laid out, and
do return for public use the following
road to wit: Beginning at Thomas Ash-
Crosby on the Township Road leading to
Philipsburg, thence south forty one degrees
and fifteen minutes East three hundred feet, thence
south thirty six degrees and thirty minutes East -
one hundred feet, thence south twelve degrees
and fifteen minutes East fifty feet, thence
south twenty degrees and forty five minutes West
fifty feet, thence south thirty seven degrees -
one hundred feet, thence south fifty degrees
and fifteen minutes West one hundred feet -
thence south fifty seven degrees and fifteen -
minutes West, one hundred feet, thence south
sixty two degrees and thirty minutes West, Two -
hundred feet, thence south fifty degrees and
fifteen minutes West, one hundred feet, thence
south thirty two degrees and thirty minutes West -
one hundred feet, to the Borough of Osceola.

Road Viewers' Report.

CLEARFIELD COUNTY, SS:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the *eighth* day of *June*, A. D. 1874, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of *Decatur*, in said county, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a ~~road or highway, leading from~~ *change of road leading* at or near *John Cramers* in *Decatur Township* to the line of *Osceola Borough*,

Report as to damages &c

And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view ^{*vacate & supply*} ~~and lay out~~ the same, according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint *S. G. Single Jesse Cops Geo Rich: Hughes*

who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said ^{*change of*} road; and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such ^{*change of*} road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same ^{*to be changed*} necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, with reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.

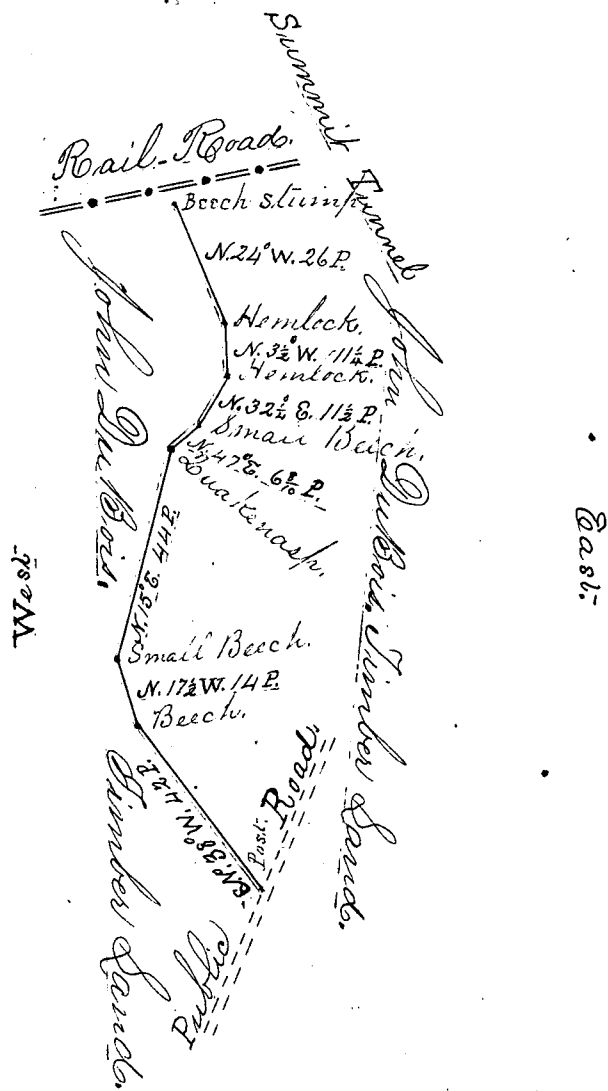
The petition of the undersigned, Res-

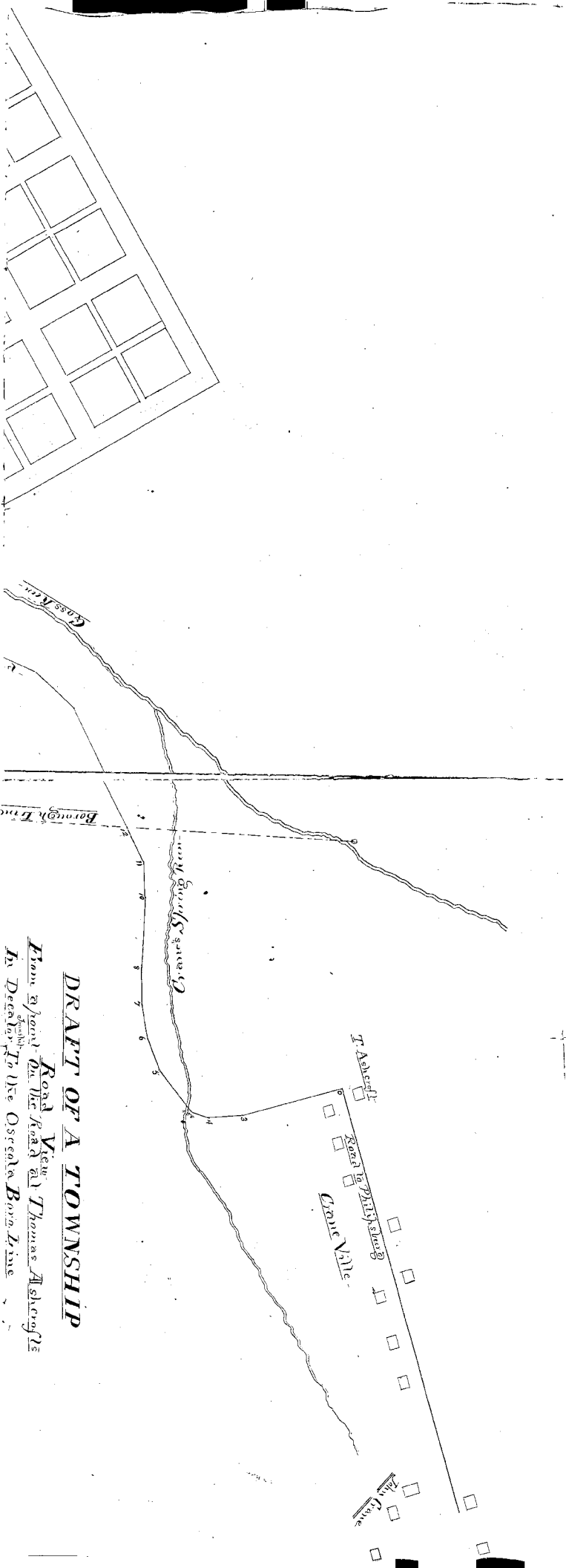
