mentioned, Respectfully report, That having given
notice of the time, and place of meeting, according to the
Act of Assembly, and being all present at the view of the said
road. And having all been sworn or affirmed in pursuance
of the said Order of Court, we have viewed and do return
the following road, viz, Beginning at the House of Thomas
Humphrey in Pike Township, in the Pub Road. Thence through
land of Richard Humphrey, South Eleven and a half degrees
west; Thirty Three perches, South Thirteen degrees west; Sixty
six & four tenths perches, South twenty three degrees East
Twenty nine perches, South forty six degrees west; Sixteen
and six tenths perches, South fourteen and a half degrees west
Sixteen and six tenths perches, South thirty four degrees East
Nine perches, South seventy two degrees East; Nine perches, North
Eighty five degrees East; Twenty One perches, North fifty degree
East; Eight perches, North Thirty nine degrees East; Eight
perches, North seventy three and a half degrees East; Eleven
perches, South seventy three degrees East; Eight perches,
South fifty seven degrees East; Ten perches, South ten degrees
East; Sixteen perches, South twenty degrees East; Twelve & three tenths
perches, North fifty six degrees East; Twenty One perches, South
Thirty six degrees East; Sixty nine and five tenths perches, to the
Public Road at Robert Owens. Which said Road as above described

Road Viewers' Report.

CLEARFIELD COUNTY, SS:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the *eight* day of *June*, A. D. 1874, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of *Pike*, in said county, setting forth that ~~they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a road or highway, leading from~~ *a certain road long since layed out has become burdensome leading from the House of Thos. Humphrey to the public near the House of Robert Owens in Pike Township*

And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and ^{*vacate*} ~~lay out~~ the same, according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint *L. F. McCloskey, Abraham Snyder and M. A. Bloom* who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said road; and if any two of them agree that there is ^{*no*} occasion for such road, they shall proceed to ^{*vacate*} ~~lay out~~ the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, ~~having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance,~~ in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, with reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.
