ROAD VIEWER'S REPORT.

CLEARFIELD COUNTY SS:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the Eighth day of June, A. D. 1874, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of Lawrence, in the said county, setting forth that ~~they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a road or highway, leading from~~ a public road leading from the mouth of Hog back run to the cross road at top of J. W. Thompsons hill which was layed out about 12 or 13 years is on bad ground - hard to open and useless when opened.

And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and ^{vacate} ~~lay out~~ the same, according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

Thos W. Moore — Mr. J. Irwin ^{and} Dean Welch

who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said road; and if any two of them agree that there is ^{an} occasion for such road, they shall proceed to ^{vacate} ~~lay out~~ the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, with reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.

To the Honorable Judges of the Court of Common Pleas and Court of Quarter Sessions held in and for Clearfield County - We the undersigned Viewers appointed by the foregoing Order of Court to view and vacate the road therein described - Do Report that in pursuance of said appointment, after having first given notice of the time & place of said vacation by written & printed advertisements put up according to Law we all met and being duly affirmed did proceed to view said road and find that said road having been Reported at March Sessions 1862. or that portion of it Beginning at the foot of the Hill about 50 Perches from the River thence South 44 degrees East - 23 Perches - South 60 degrees East - 24 Perches - South 53 degrees East - 28 Perches - South 60 degrees East 16 Perches - South 66 East - 22 Perches South 58 degrees East 22 Perches - South 37 degrees East 12 Perches - South 11 degrees East - 18 Perches - South 38 degrees East - 6 Perches - South 56 degrees East - 28 Perches - South 46 degrees East 18 Perches - South 53 degrees East 22 Perches to the Cross roads - never having been opened and if opened would in our opinion be but little if any better than the road now in use, and should be vacated a Plot or Draft of which we hereto annex which we Submit in testimony whereof we have hereunto set our hands this 15th Day of August 1874
