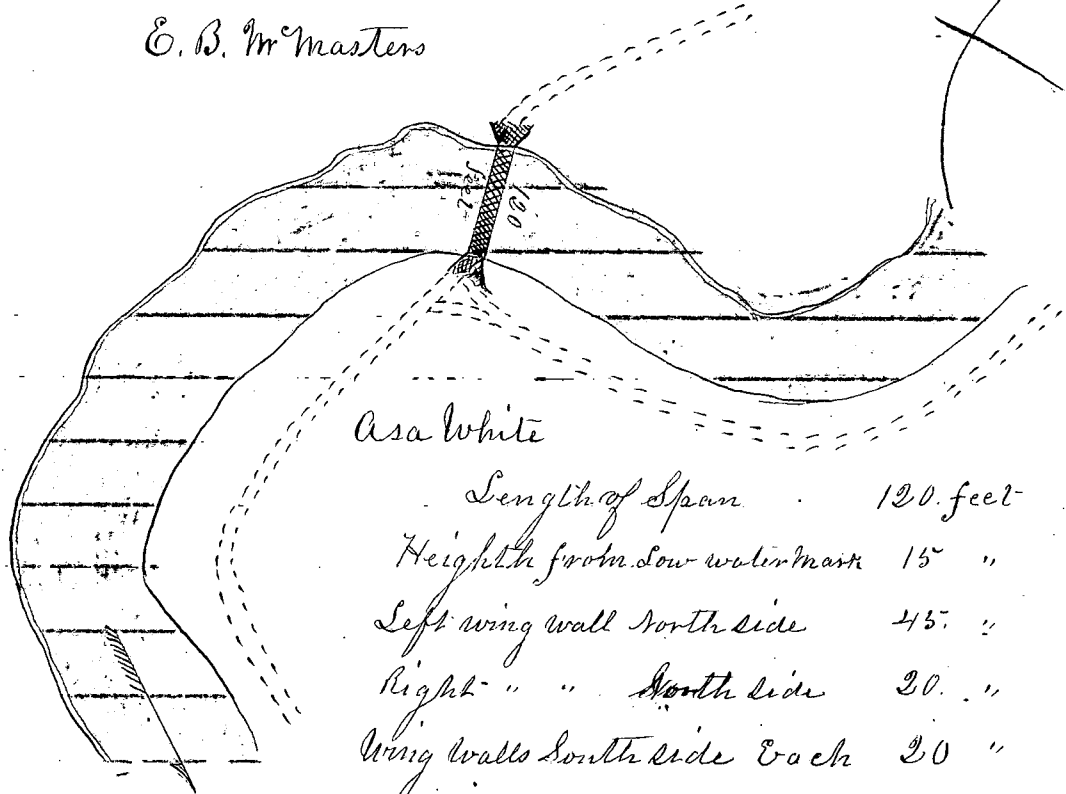

We the undersigned, persons appointed by the within
Order of Court: to view the Site for a Bridge across
the Susquehanna River, near the Town of Burnside
in Burnside Township, Respectfully report,
That having given notice of the time, and
place of meeting according to the act of as-
sembly, and being all present at the view of
the Site proposed for the said Bridge, and
having all been sworn, or affirmed, in pursu-
ance of the said Order of Court: we find
That the length of the span, at that point (one
span being all necessary) would be One hundred
and twenty feet (120), height ^{of bridge} from low water
mark, fifteen feet (15). Left wing wall on North
side forty five feet (45) right wing wall on North
side, Twenty feet (20) Wing walls on South side each
Twenty feet (20) A plan or draft whereof is herein
to annexed, We are of opinion that the expense
of Building said Bridge will be about Three Thousand
Dollars, And we are of opinion that the expense of
Building the said Bridge, (which said Bridge we are
of opinion is necessary) would be too great for one
or two Townships to bear, we recommend that the
County assist them in building it.

Road Viewers' Report.

CLEARFIELD COUNTY, SS:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the leighth day of June, A. D. 1874, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of Burnside, in said county, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a ~~road or highway, leading from~~ Across the River in Burnside Township, Clearf. Co., Pa. at the place where the public road leading from Clearf to Burnside crosses said River

And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and ^{Report} ~~lay out~~ the same, according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

S. L. McCloskey, Thos. A. McLee & A. White who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said ^{Bridge} ~~road~~; and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such ^{Bridge} ~~road~~, they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a ^{Bridge} ~~road~~, and the ^{Bridge} ~~state whether you deem the expenses of said Bridge to great for Burnside to bear~~ shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make

report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary ~~for a public or private road~~, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, with reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.
