Read Viewers' Report.

CLEARFIELD COUNTY, SS:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the 13th day of June, A. D. 1875, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of ~~Woodward~~ ^{Knox}, in said county, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a ~~road~~ ^{Bridge} on highway, leading from Thomas Hendersons in Woodward Township To New Millport in Knox Township at the ford on said road ~~where~~ on the line of the two townships

And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same, according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

G. H. Lytle J. S. Williams Ed John F. Hile

who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said road; and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make

report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, with reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.

The petition of the undersigned, inhabitants of the Township of Knox and Woodward in the said County, respectfully sheweth, That a Bridge is much wanted over Clearfield Creek at the place where the public road leading from the Hendersons in Woodward Township to New Millport in Knox Township crosses the said creek on the line between the two Townships before mentioned. The ford there being frequently rendered impassable by reason of ice and high waters; and that the expense of erecting said Bridge would be too heavy and burdensome upon the inhabitants of said Townships. Your petitioners therefore pray your Honors to appoint proper persons to view the premises and take such order on the subject as is required and directed by the Act of the General Assembly in such case made and provided.
