Order to View Road.

Clearfield County 88,

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, held at Clearfield in and for said County, on the 27 day of Sep 1895 before the judges of the said Court upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the Townships Girard and Graham setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a public road or highway leading from the public road at the mouth of Deer Creek in Girard Tp, by the way of the new Bridge across the Susquehanna to at or near the residence of Thos St. Lorcey in Graham Tp.

And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same according, whereupon the Court upon due consideration had of the premises do order and appoint Francis Hugar, Ferd Mignot & John S. Tury who after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity are to view the ground proposed for said road and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such road they shall proceed to lay out the same as agreeable to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road and shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses thereof, with reference to the improvements through which it may pass to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held in said County. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law. Report as to damages &c.

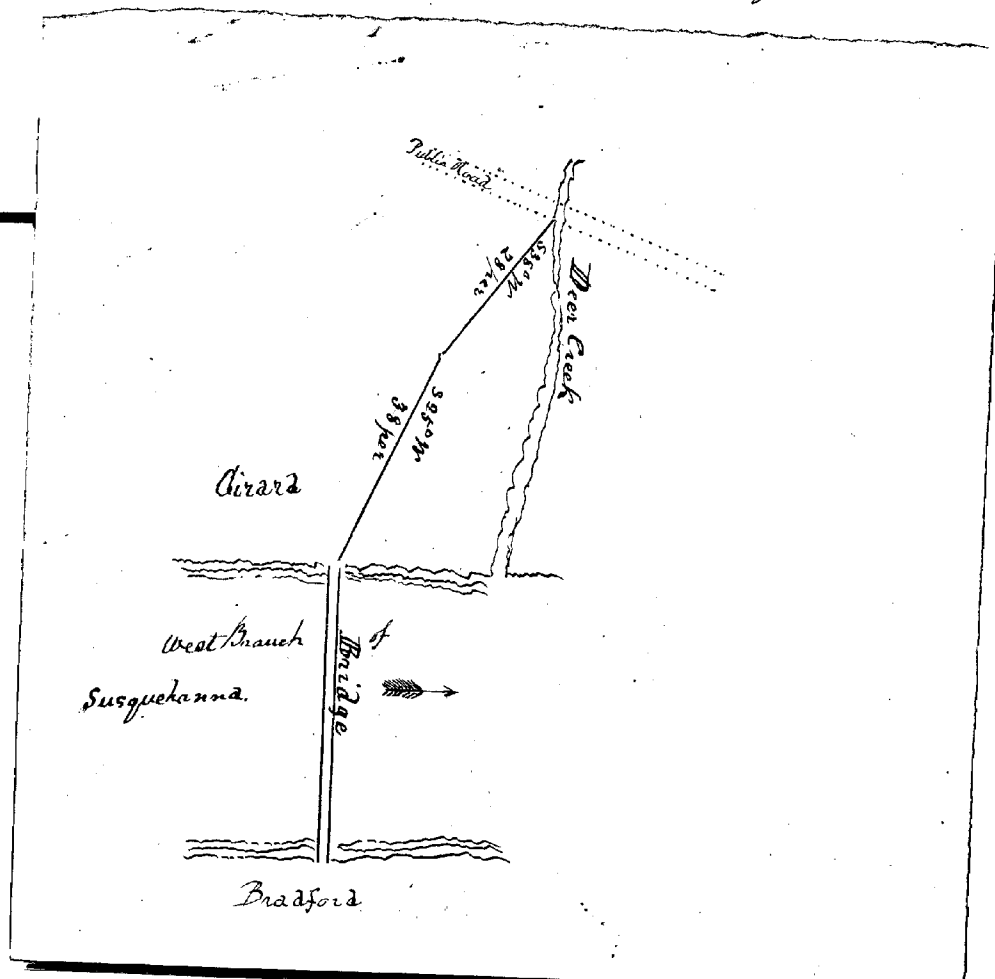
To the Honorable the judges of the

The undersigned viewers duly
appointed to view and lay out a
road to lead from the Public Road at
the mouth of Deer-Creek to the new
Bridge and to at or near the house
of J. H. Torrey in Graham Township
in and by virtue of the order of Court
hereto annexed.

Respectfully Report, that having
given due timely and legal notice of
the time and place of the meeting of
the viewers, by notices posted in public
places for more than Five days previous
to making the view that we all met upon
the grounds and being first duly sworn
according to law after examining the grounds
proposed for said road we proceeded to lay
out the following road. Beginning at a point
in Public Road at the mouth of Deer-Creek thence
South thirty eight-degrees West Twenty eight-
perches and South Twenty Five degrees West-
Thirty eight-perches to entrance of new Bridge
which Road we return for Public use and consider
the same to be necessary No damages assessed all
of which is respectfully submitted
